Dear parishioners,

Some people have reported that at a moment when they might have been close to dying, their life flashed before their eyes. I wonder how much it includes because I would really like to watch what happened at my baptism. This weekend we hear about the baptism of Jesus. It was pretty sensational with John the Baptist wondering why he isn't the one being baptized by Jesus and then to have God the Father pronounce, "This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased." None of us have had a baptism as dramatic as that one. But the moment of our baptism could be considered more significant than when Jesus was baptized. That baptism didn't change him or his status. Our baptism changed us drastically. We went from a creature of very little significance to a child of God. That is a far greater change than a gnat being given the status of being a member of your family.

The full life cycle of a gnat is about two weeks. It would be tough for them to get the inheritance that you could offer them. By the time you got the will written up, ratified, and processed after your death, they would be long gone.

But God has taken care of those details of our drastic change of status. He has given us a soul that is immortal. Jesus died and rose from the dead to help us understand that it is not just our souls that will live on, but our bodies will also be raised up and glorified so we will be able to accept the inheritance and be able to live in the kingdom he has prepared for us. So, it will not be just two weeks or 90 years that we have in order to enjoy what he has in store for us, but an eternity. So many people don't understand this dramatic change. They will base their lives on a birth certificate, a marriage license, or some other paper that comes from the government, but they aren't ready to recognize the power of a certificate of baptism or holy matrimony to validate the bonds that God made real at those sacraments. There was no mark on their body to signify their citizenship or the equivalent for the bond of matrimony. There were only the symbols (rings, marriage license, etc.) to verify the change of status. It is the same with the sacraments. There are only the symbols (water, a candle, oils, certificates, rings, etc.) to validate the new citizenship in heaven or the bond that God blessed from heaven.

Each of the sacraments has these outward signs of something amazing happening. At the end of my life, I hope to view these sacramental events again, but also the actual power and significance behind them. That will be nice assurance as I enter the gates of heaven to know that I won't just have the life-span of a gnat to be there.
