402-843-2345 Know Your Faith: Papal Infallibility by Fr. Sund

> The teaching of papal infallibility is a teaching of the Church with which many people struggle to understand. Jesus Christ, before he ascended to heaven, promised to send the gift of the Holy Spirit upon the disciples. In Matthew 16:18 -19 Jesus gave the Keys of the Kingdom of Heaven to Peter. He also gives Peter the power to "bind" and "loose." Along with this is the promise that "the gates of hell will not prevail against (The Church)"

The promise of guidance and protection of the Holy Spirit is the teaching of Papal Infallibility established in scripture. The Pope, who is the successor of Peter, is protected by the Holy Spirit from error in matters of faith and morals. Christ gave this to protect the teachings of Christ and the Apostles that have been handed on to us.

Does this mean that the Pope can teach that the world is flat, murder is right and 2+2=5? The extent of the gift of infallibility given to St. Peter and his successors is not speaking of a guarantee of personal morality or the ability to change the teachings of Jesus or basic facts of the world. This infallibility is stated to be so when it is "in communion with the bishops of the world and the teaching of Christ and his Church". This promise is so that we, the faithful, may be instructed rightly in the faith and living the moral life.

The Pope must intend to speak in the manner of his teaching office. Often, you may hear the saying that the Pope has spoken "Ex Cathedra" (literally "From the Chair") This means that he speaks from the authority of the Chair or Keys of Peter. This has happened only a few times in Papal Encyclicals and other formal teachings.






