#### <Know Your Faith >

#### Why do we Pray? And How?

One of the better definitions I have found from prayer actually comes from the Baltimore Chatechism. Question 304 is answered: "Prayer is the lifting up of our minds and hearts to God to adore Him, to thank Him for His benefits, to ask His forgiveness, and to beg Him all the graces we need whether for soul or body." This answer is looking at the basic elements of the Our Father, which Jesus laid out as the perfect prayer.

When we pray however we should not just blast through prayers but rather lift our minds and hearts in prayer. This means deliberately thinking about and raising our heart to the words we are praying with (or the image, text or song). This type of prayer is called mediation and is done to bring us to be in the presence of God and to let our hearts rejoice in his delights.

Think about it in this way. If I can spend time raising my heart and my mind to the happiness that is found in God, my life should be affected in such a way that I will desire more greatly these heavenly things.

If you are a cradle Catholic, you most likely learned a set of prayers that you had to know by heart: Our Father, Hail Mary, Bless Us O Lord, Act of Contrition, the Apostles Creed, the Nicene Creed, the Glory is... (We could keep listing them.)

As young children, it's always good to memorize as these prayers become part of our ordinary day. Yet, as we grow older, we don't want to fall into the trap that they become too ordinary. If the purpose of prayer is to bring my heart to God's and to contemplate the higher things than the words of these many prayers, we have memorized can help us in raising our minds.

Have you ever taken the time to slowly pray the Our Father and think about every word? It's a tremendous prayer that speaks about our Lord's great care for us and our knowledge of the need to ask for it! The same with the prayers of the Mass. It can become simple repetition – or it can be a wellspring of riches each time we enter. Take the time to reflect on the words!
