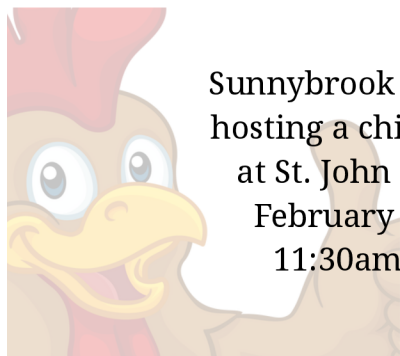

Dear parishioners,

This past week I have been reflecting on the different styles of preaching that have happened in the last few generations. My parents lived through the fire and brimstone preachers. Everyone back then knew they had a good chance to end up in hell. It scared people, but it was felt that the rigidity, along with the fear, might drive people away. One of the priests I grew up with gave one fiery homily but the next day he apologized for it. I'm guessing that he was receiving some pressure. I had actually been fired up by the sermon and was disappointed when he backed off. That was the era after the Vatican II when the push was to try to be gentler with the hopes of reuniting the different Christian denominations. It had limited success, but by then almost all preaching focused on the love of God.

Soon it wasn't just the love of God, but the unconditional love of God. It has almost wiped out any concept of judgment but was developed to get people into the door of the church. That also had limited success. People were coming into the door, but they weren't staying because they figured that there was no difference between attending or not attending, since there weren't any consequences from a God who loves unconditionally.

While this went on, morality seemed to become an option. Abortion went from a sin to a right. Sexuality went from God's goal of a man and a woman uniting in Holy Matrimony, to the point where experts can't agree on what a man or a woman is. The biggest consequence of these last changes is that it involves so many people that it seems like just about everyone is so deep into the new cultural trends, that judging according to biblical standards would condemn most of the population. So now preachers are attacked for even mentioning anything except the concept of unconditional love, which is usually translated into a demand for tolerance.

What will the new preaching be like? What will the next generation of priests be dealing with? Because the demand for tolerance definitely does not include tolerance for a message against immoral behavior. Please pray for our priests and seminarians.

One of them you can pray for is me. This Thursday I will be the spiritual director for the trip to Mexico that you heard about in the bulletin a few months ago. There are over twenty of us going to see the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe and work with the Hope for the Poor workers down there in Mexico City. I will return late on Wednesday, 2/4.
