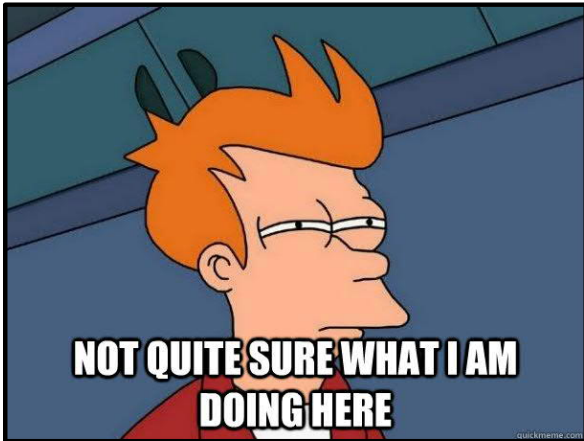

DOES JESUS COME TO DESTROY US? OR TO SAVE US?

In the Gospel passage today (Mk 1:21-28), a man possessed by an unclean spirit makes accusations against Jesus... "Have you come to destroy us?" While we are not possessed, I think that the fear raised is one that can challenge us... 'What does Jesus do to us?' and 'How will I become changed and different because of my relationship with Jesus?'

WILL I SURVIVE A RELATIONSHIP WITH JESUS?

Frank Sinatra sang a song "I did it my way." It claims that I am who I am because I am the summation of my decisions and choices. Ultimately, the song implies a type of control over life and one's destiny. The words of the song don't give much room for a Savior to do things 'His way'.

Jesus desires to save and redeem us. He sets us free from sin. He brings reconciliation and forgiveness into our world. He's the one who justifies us and brings us into the gates of heaven. While heaven is our true homeland, we cannot 'earn' a ticket of admission. Jesus is the reason that we make it through the door. Getting into heaven is 'His way'.

A relationship with Jesus changes us in many ways. Just as a real, deep friendship changes us by the care and concern we have for a friend and that the friend has for us, so too a relationship with Jesus changes us by the care and concern we have for him and by the care and concern that he has for us (It's always been there, but in this way we begin to notice it!). Will I survive a relationship with Jesus? Yes! Will I be changed by this relationship? Yes.

Fear and apprehension are overcome by the strength of the relationship, which is something that takes time, track record, and established trust to accomplish. The familiarity of the relationship is something that helps us to know the person with

whom we are in relationship. We also grow in the acceptance, comfort, and knowledge of being known, loved, accepted, and forgiven by Jesus.

Friendship is a type of love, and love always changes us.

DIFFERENT LOVE LANGUAGES... SPEAKING AND LISTENING

Gary Chapman has a book entitled *The Five Love Languages* in which he proposes that there are different ways in which we try and communicate love. He lists these five love languages:

1. Physical Touch
2. Words of Affirmation
3. Quality Time
4. Gift Giving
5. Acts of Service

His proposal is that each of these skills is like a different language like English, French, German, Italian, or Chinese. My native language is English... it is how I normally think and conceptualize and communicate. However, I have also studied Italian and I can speak it in a more limited way. If someone speaks German or Chinese, I'd be completely lost and wouldn't understand.

If I think of doing something 'loving' for another person, one of these five is more likely to be the natural way in which I would act. This would be how I would 'speak' a love language. At the same time, there may be a different love language in which I am used to 'hearing' or 'understanding' love being spoken to me.

LOVE OF GOD AND LOVE OF NEIGHBOR

Living our life of faith is always challenging, and 'the now' is no exception. It is a personal challenge for you and me to live and witness faith... we don't always do this 100% of the time. Additionally, the world in which we live...out context for living faith... discounts faith as something unnecessary or not of worth or not relevant or not a priority. This is the background in which we are choosing to practice our faith. You probably noticed that you don't tend to end up at church by accident... but by choice.

SUPPORTING EACH OTHER IN FAITH

In so many parts of life, we accept the gift of companionship and support. Somehow, though, we feel that faith is an exception to that. We can think that it is a personal experience only. The truth is that faith shared is faith strengthened. I encourage you to find a way to share about your life of faith. Maybe you don't know how to put your faith into words...that's ok. Faith is a language, and it is learned by speaking and sharing it.

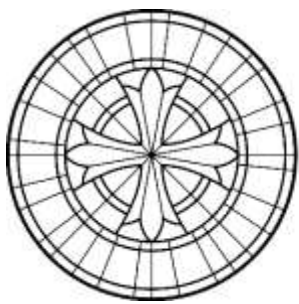

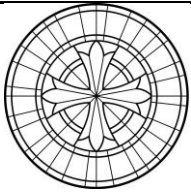

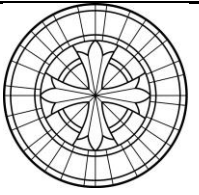
