

## FASTING & ABSTINENCE REGULATIONS



### Fasting:

- \*those between the ages of 18 and 59 are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday
- \*this consists of 1 full meal and 2 smaller meals during the day, without snacks
- \*if one cannot for health reasons, they are exempt

### Abstinence from meat:

- \*those age 14 and older are required to not eat meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent.



## DID YOU KNOW?

### \*Lent is 40 days long\*

It mirrors the 40 days Jesus spent fasting in the desert, as well as Moses' 40 day on Mount Sinai and Elijah's 40-day journey to Horeb

### \*Sundays are not counted in Lent\*

Every Sunday is considered a "mini-Easter," a celebration of the Resurrection, even during this penitential season

### \*The word "Lent" comes from an Old English word\*

Meaning "springtime" or "lengthening of days," symbolizing spiritual renewal and growth

### \*Ash Wednesday ashes come from last year's Palm Sunday palms\*

Reminding us of the cycle of repentance, forgiveness, and new life

### \*Purple is the liturgical color of Lent\*

It represents repentance, humility, and preparation for Christ's Passion

### \*Fasting during Lent dates back to the early Church\*

With some early Christians fasting daily until evening throughout the entire season

### \*Lent originally prepared new Christians for Baptism\*

Which took place at the Easter Vigil--making Lent a season of renewal for the whole church

### \*The final two weeks of Lent are called "Passiontide"\*

When the Church focuses more intensely on Christ's suffering and sacrifice

### \*Lent is not meant to be gloomy\*

It is a season of hope, inviting us to turn our hearts back to God and prepare joyfully for Easter

**From the Desk of  
Father Frank**



Dear parishioners,

The trip to Mexico City was very educational. Over the next weeks, I will be writing about some of those learning opportunities. The first one fits right into this week's reminder that we are dust and to dust we will return, Ash Wednesday. We were working with the group called Hope for the Poor. One of the things that this organization works on is getting people off the street. There were two main categories. Single men who left home when they were 8-12 years old because they had been physically abused by their fathers. In other words, they had been treated like dirt. The other group was the women who had been physically and sexually abused by family members. They had left home from 8-14 years old and some of them were already pregnant. They had been treated like dirt or simple objects for someone's sick gratification. They also felt they would be safer living on the streets than at home. Along with these women were their children, for some of them have been raped on the streets, had to prostitute themselves, or trusted the wrong man.

According to the second chapter of Genesis, Adam was made from the clay of the ground, dirt. Then, Eve was made from him. We are more like Eve. We come from someone else, our parents, but we eat things that are grown in the soil or eat those things that eat what grows from the soil. We are dirt. The difference between our situation and the homeless is that most of us are not treated like dirt. Each of them had their struggles with illegal drugs. They took those drugs to have a moment of feeling great. The problem is that it didn't last and only made things worse. What little faith that they might have had in God before they left home was gone. Their thought was that God didn't care about the dirt He created, so why believe in Him.

The task for the Hope for the Poor group and my traveling companions was to help them realize that there was another option. First, they were sent to rehab to get off the drugs. In Mexico you can commit someone. They don't have to go of their own free will. Also, the treatment is far less expensive. If I heard correctly, \$3000 per person was the cost for three months. The next step was to get them into an apartment with minimum furnishings. They had to earn each extra piece of furniture by participating in the retraining process. This involved learning how to be a healthy member of a larger family of people in their same situation. We were to be role models. They had to learn that there were some people who they could trust. These men, women, children, and babies had learned that they should not trust anyone. The women and children had to move each day so they wouldn't be victimized again. The long-term goal was to help them learn to trust the right people and then to learn to trust God.

Starting with Ash Wednesday, we repeat a similar process. Do we trust God? If you hear yourself saying, "Why me"; you still have work to do. We are encouraged to let go of the things of this world that we hold onto for security and pray for the Resurrection. (More next week.)
