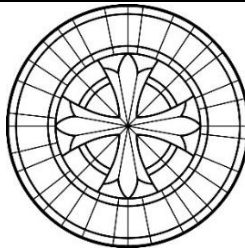

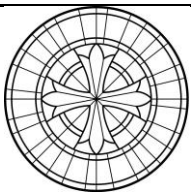

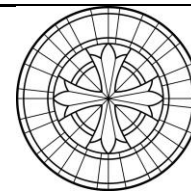

Fasting Regulations:

Fasting - Those between the ages of 18 and 59 are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This consists of 1 full meal and 2 smaller meals during the day, without snacks. If one cannot for health reasons, they are exempt.

Abstinence from Meat - Those age 14 and older are required to not eat meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent.
