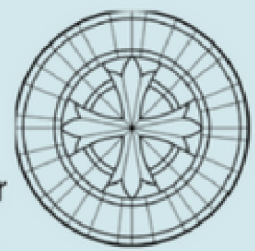

We received more than 50 name submissions.

These submissions were reviewed by the Family of Parishes Planning Team (FPPT), which has a representative from each of the 8 church communities. After removing the submissions that did not meet the criteria, the list was condensed to the names submitted for The Archbishop's consideration.

A major motivating point of pursuing parish mergers is that it accomplishes the goal of reducing administrative complexity while allowing each of our church communities the ability to maintain their physical campuses.

We submitted four pairings as suggestions. Our recommendation and preference are for Annunciation Parish and Visitation Parish, as we have been praying for Mary's intercession with the Memorare throughout this Journey of Faith process at Mass. This allows us to give Mary a place of prominence, while still being able to acknowledge the particular church campus during our community worship in the Eucharistic Prayers.

When we hear back from The Archbishop, we will let you know.

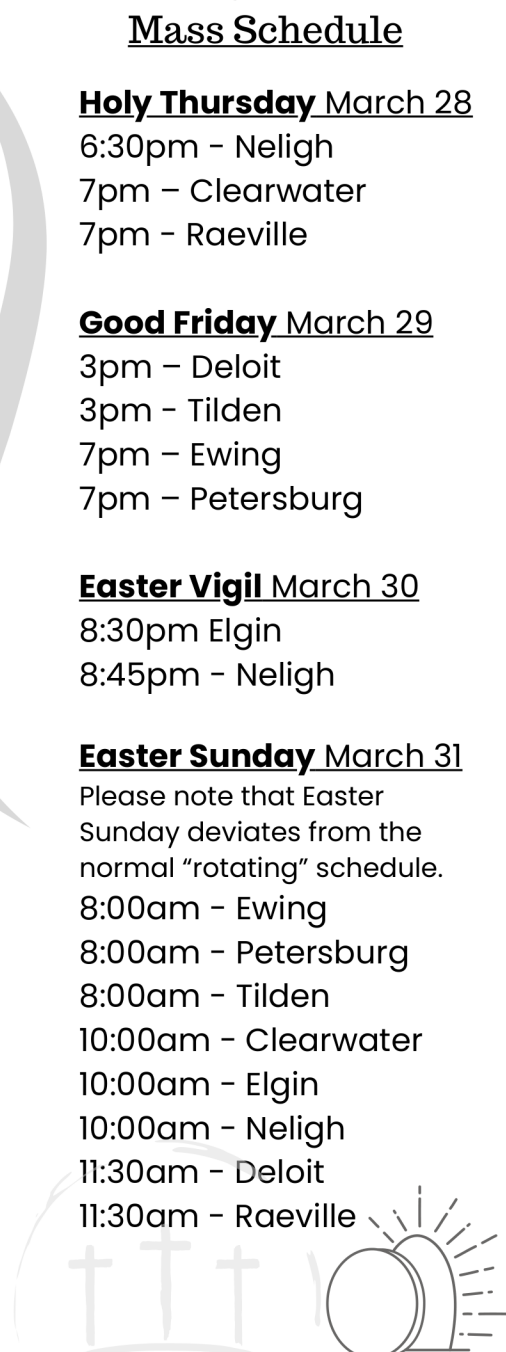

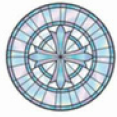
