# Know Your Faith: Why No Meat?

During the Lenten season, the Church requires that on Fridays of Lent all Catholics over the age of fourteen refrain from the consumption of meat. Why meat?

The Latin word for meat is "caro" which is a word directly meaning flesh meat. So it is really that on Friday's in Lent we don't eat flesh. (Fish has never been considered "caro")

The symbolism here should stick out. Christ offers his flesh for us, and so it is a very small act of us to give up the eating of fleshy meat. Absitence is a form of self-denial that helps us to grow in holiness. Another reason of giving up meat is that it helps us to identify with the poor of the world who do not have such luxuries.
