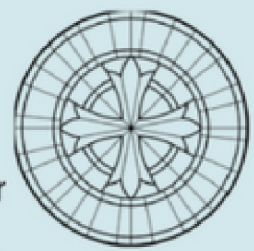

Who is Saint Patrick?

St. Patrick of Ireland was born in Britain, captured by pirates when he was fourteen, & was a slave in Ireland herding & tending sheep. Rescued by Sailors at age twenty, he was reunited with his family. He later became a Priest & returned to Ireland where he converted many people -eventually thousands- and built churches across all of Ireland. He often used shamrocks to explain the Holy Trinity. After years of living in poverty, traveling & enduring much suffering Patrick died on March 17, 461.

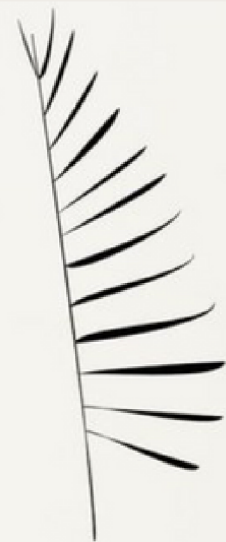
