Dear parishioners,

Last week I described the mess we have here in the U.S.A. and in Mexico City. It is easier to come up with a cure for the problem in another culture. We can look at the problem of abuse in Mexico City and figure out that they just have to be nicer to their children. Nothing to it. Well, first you must heal the wounds that come from the previous generations and then fix the culture of alcohol and drugs, so it doesn't get in the way of healing. Then you must have good examples of healthy families as a model for people to live by. Then you must have punishments for abuse so those who are weak are motivated to stay on track. As I said, nothing to it.

Then we can figure out how to solve the problems of an over sexualized culture here in the U.S. All we have to do is change the multi-trillion-dollar pornography industry to be less lucrative, so they go out of business. Then we need to turn Hollywood away from producing shows that glorify immoral behavior. After that, we must find a way to cure three generations of people who have become addicted to pornography and a constant longing for instant gratification to all their sexual desires. Convincing our tech industry leaders to abandon their work to produce AI sex partners would be next. With that all in place, we will need to have punishments for those who are too weak to stay on track, so they don't start the whole cycle again. Within all of that, we need to build healthy family models that appreciate God's beautiful gift of sexuality without turning it into an addiction. And before I forget, we would have to eliminate artificial means of birth control and all forms of abortion which I am convinced the devil set up to make it easier to become sex addicts by eliminating those bizarre consequences called children.

Notice how Jesus goes through Passion (Palm) Sunday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter without once dealing with the issue of dying a virgin. He would not have made a good citizen of the U.S. Hopefully we can learn from the services of Holy Week, how to have a better focus on what is truly important.
