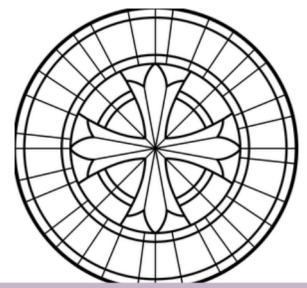

Know Your Faith - What Happened to the People that Died before Jesus?

We know that those who are baptized and die in the state of grace (without mortal sin) will enjoy eternal life with God in heaven. This was made possible through the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ in which we enter into through our own baptism. This becomes a little more complicated; when we talk about those who lived righteous lives and loved God above all things who died before the death and resurrection of Jesus. We rarely hear people say: "Saint Adam or Saint Abraham or Saint Moses." However, in faith and tradition we do believe that when Jesus descended among the dead (on Holy Saturday) he brought those souls and many others to himself. There is an ancient Holy Saturday homily that speaks of Jesus' descent into the realm of the dead. He meets Adam and Eve and Jesus says to Adam: "Awake, O sleeper, and arise from the dead, and Christ shall give you light." The Catechism of the Catholic Church in par 631-636 recalls that Jesus descended into Sheol or Hades to preach the Gospel to those who had died and were awaiting him. This does not mean that the wicked were freed but only those who were righteous and loved God. As Christians then we can truly believe that the prophets who were often killed and persecuted for speaking the truth of God were brought to heaven as the first to share in Jesus' resurrection!

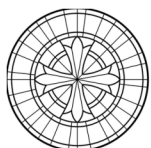

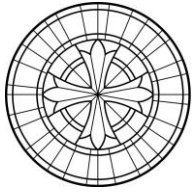


OUR MISSION

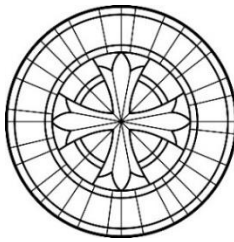
