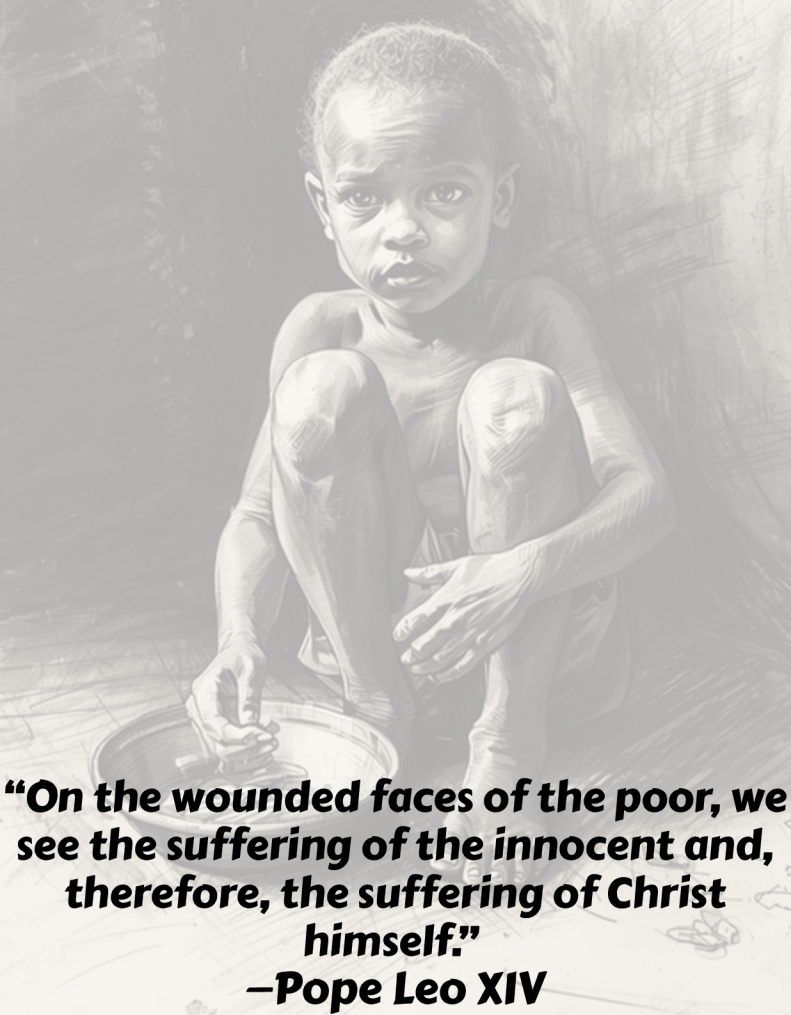

Dear parishioners,

Last week I ended with the idea that I still needed to solve the problem. Luckily, I don't need to solve it. The Catholic Church has already been teaching it, and it is all about love. But it may not be the kind of love that is adding to the problem. Examples of the problematic love are all around us. Sex before marriage, adultery, same sex unions opening the door to more options of gender connections, and their result of broken families, broken individuals, and aborted babies. Those are the result of God's gift of sex without acknowledging His boundaries.

So, what does the Catholic Church offer in terms of love? Most people think in terms of those darn commandments and rules that restrict the expression of love. Yes, those are there but let me guide you to a more positive look at the church's offering. It starts with a question. What is the most loving thing you can do for a person? Answer, Get them to heaven! Join them to the love of God for eternity. In comparison to that, everything else is almost pathetic. I don't know about all priests, but the ones I have talked to tell the couples they prepare for marriage that their main job is to get each to heaven. It is not to give them the greatest sexual experience possible.

It is not new, but too many couples start their relationship sexually. It becomes their priority. Then, when it isn't clicking, there is a problem. The message of having celibate priests is; what would life be like if God hadn't given us that gift of our sexuality. He could have made us like amoebas, so we would split in half occasionally and become two. Instead, he made us two so that we could become one, not just with each other but within His love. That is the difference between the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony and just getting married. God is involved. He made it possible for that union to become fruitful. This is not just to make another human being but to have another person fulfill their destiny and join Him in heaven also.

Last week, when I mentioned that our problem is that we have become oversexualized, I meant that it has become our focus. We base almost everything on sex and gender, and not on God. The gender craziness is people looking for love in all the wrong ways. Families broken apart and forming new bonds, or more satisfying partners, are destroying too many people. Young people are looking for a mate similar to how animals operate, rather than someone to help them grow in holiness. Animals don't think about holiness.

During Holy Week, you are led by the church to focus on who and what leads us to heaven. You will not hear anything about our sexuality. It is a weeklong message that needs to be heard by celibates, married couples, single people, and children. If this seems simplistic, you really need to attend more services during Holy Week and beyond, rather than just looking for the most convenient Easter Mass to attend. It is not simplistic. It is difficult. It is a hard journey but look at where the path of sexualization has led our country. It seemed so easy at first to focus on this aspect of pleasure. After all, it is all about love. But now look at how hard it seems to dig our way out of this mess. And with that thought you might get some insight into why Jesus took on so much suffering on the cross, and why He tells us that we must also be willing to carry our cross.

One particular notice regarding this focus on Jesus has to do with Eucharistic Adoration which is associated with 1st Friday at St. Francis in Neligh and St. Boniface in Elgin. Adoration after the Holy Thursday services will replace April's 1st Friday times. Holy Thursday services will be held at St. Francis in Neligh and St. Bonaventure in Raeville this year. Eucharistic adoration will be available in those churches starting around 8pm until midnight. This is to remind us of how Jesus asked his apostles to spend time with him in the garden of Gethsemane. They had a hard time staying awake in prayer for one hour that night. Hopefully many of you can do better in one of those churches between 8pm and midnight.

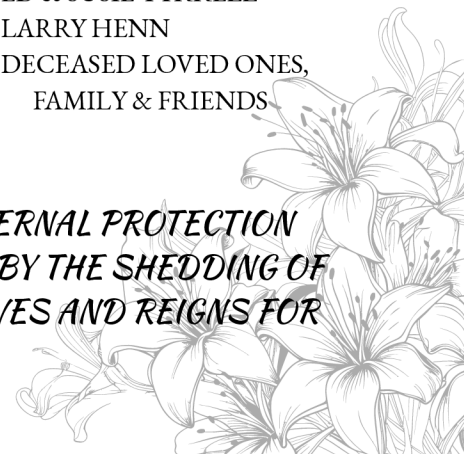
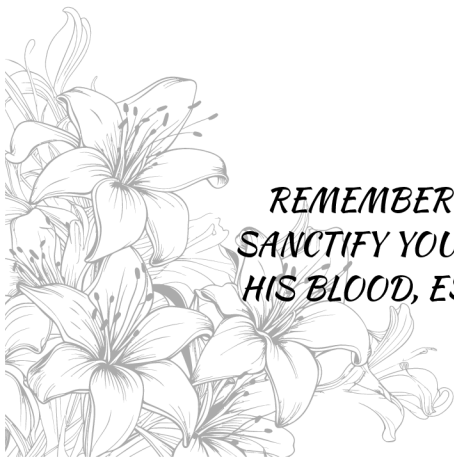
