Easter defeats the prideful, selfish, self-reliance that rejects a Savior... Jesus reveals how completely unconditional the love of God is for us... The sacrifice of Jesus was motivated by selfless love... For love of us, Jesus considered the cross to be worth it.

Easter defeats the tyranny of the same-old, same-old... Jesus leads us in a life of faith...Faith grows the trust that we have in God for embarking on the adventures that are placed in our lives...
