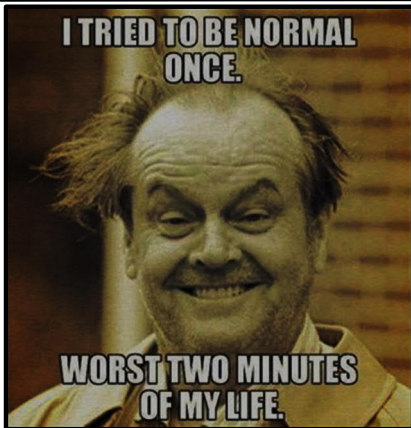

GETTING READY FOR THE NEXT TRANSITION TOWARD NORMAL
Archbishop Lucas announced that he intends to remove the general dispensation for Sunday Mass on Pentecost, May 22-23, 2021. While many people have expressed a desire to be back in church... several people have told me "Father, we just felt it was time to be back"... the Archbishop hopes to accomplish two things by this change.

First, he wants to clarify that we have an obligation and responsibility to nurture and live our faith. The general dispensation was enacted so quickly at the beginning of the pandemic that we didn't clarify and teach well that the Sunday obligation exists to help us live our personal responsibility for our life of faith. At times, it became an easy excuse to say that I'm still fulfilling the Church's obligations of me, even if I do nothing. The dispensation of the Sunday obligation did not dispense us of the responsibility to seek the Lord and grow in faith in this meantime.

Families being responsible for the keeping of the faith and the passing on of the faith is not new to our parish stories. In my reading of our parish histories from our parish and community milestone books and the Franciscans in Nebraska book, our church communities started out as families of believers. They would welcome the priest into their homes for church when he was passing through on his ministry circuit. Priests stopped where there were communities of believers and supported them as best he could. The church buildings came later, as did priests taking residence in our communities. Our way forward continues with the opportunity to worship, the reinstated obligation to worship, and the always present responsibility to keep the faith.

Secondly, the Archbishop wants to make clear that faith is not a 'solo sport.' Faith is meant to be experienced, shared, and strengthened in a community. My personal relationship with the Lord is essential, as is my communal relationship with the Lord. We are a family in faith. Our parishes are family, which is another layer of relationships within the Body of Christ.

OUR STEPS FORWARD... PLANNING, PREP, AND INVITATION

There are differences about the situations that exist in different parts of our diocese, state, and country. My experience of visiting my parents in the Omaha area is very different from my experience out here. COVID has not gone away, but the increased availability of vaccines, our more distanced general way of life, and the relatively low rates of infections within our local communities allow us to provide more normal options than some of the urban and suburban parishes.

I want to be intentional with my language... we are providing normal options... Options give you a choice on how to participate or not.

Beginning the weekend of May 1-2, we will try to have Mass 'as normal as possible' ...

- People can choose to space themselves as they wish within the church building.
- The sign of peace will be offered... and you can choose to shake hands or nod or not participate. People have different comfort levels and we want to respect that.
- The children's collection will be offered as it was pre-pandemic.
- Hospitality ministry like greeters and ushers are able to welcome people as they would pre-pandemic... and sometimes that means that ushers are overly optimistic about how many people fit in a pew.
- Ministry to the homebound by EMHCs, deacons, and others will resume as pre-pandemic.
- Gifts will be brought forward.
- Walking forward for communion will be as it was pre-pandemic.
- Hospitality after Mass like coffee and rolls, etc. can be offered as the parish would do pre-pandemic.

These are options of what we are choosing to do. This may not be your experience if you go to other churches, especially in larger areas... and it is possible that we will need to adjust again as our own circumstances change.

Additionally, most of our online ministry will come to an end... Our last livestreamed Mass will be May 15-16. My last reflection will be Tuesday May 18.

EXEMPTIONS UNDER THE SUNDAY OBLIGATION

As a final note, the Archbishop's directive still offers exemptions due to advanced age, sickness, disability, or some other serious reason. For the foreseeable future he offers an exemption for those who feel they are at heightened risk of contracting or communicating COVID-19 are excused.

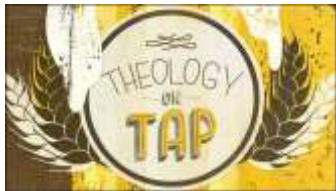

Notice regarding Pope John Recycling Program



In an effort to eliminate the problems caused by having shredded paper blown all around the neighborhood, the large plastic bags containing shredded paper are to be placed in the recycle bins.

Small plastic bags and all cardboard boxes containing paper products must be emptied.

Only cardboard boxes that are completely flattened may be placed in the bins.

Only large plastic bags containing shredded paper must be placed in the bins.

If we continue to have issues with shredded paper after a trial period, we will no longer be able to collect it.

NOTE: Complete lists of acceptable and non-acceptable items for recycling are attached to the bins.

Pope John Recycling Program

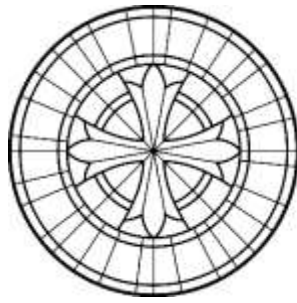


Two recycle bins are placed on the north side of the garage next to the St. Boniface Gym. Papers/acceptable recyclables can be put in the bins whenever it is convenient for you. Acceptable items

are: Newspapers, office paper, phone books, paperback books, paper bags, cereal boxes, Kleenex boxes, pop & beer boxes, magazines, and mailings. The bins are emptied on Wednesdays. If they are full when you come, please place your recyclables in the garage. The list of unacceptable items includes: plastic bags, string, metal, wire, aluminum cans, glass, styrofoam, trash, feed sacks, used pizza boxes and other boxes that contained prepared food. 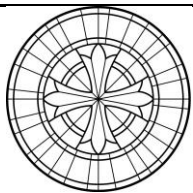

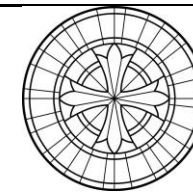
