The Faith Walk

AND HE WALKS WITH ME...AND HE TALKS WITH ME...

This Sunday the Gospel passage (Lk 24: 13-35) has the disciples who encounter Jesus on the road to Emmaus. Some strong preferences for these journeys were that they happen during the day and you should not travel alone. This was for one's personal security and safety, lest you meet robbers and thieves along the way.

Growing up, my family lived about a half mile from school. We would walk home on most days...my brother and sisters, family friends, and neighbors. If we were full strength, we would be eight walking together. Our parents' concern for our safety was that we were safer together. They were right. There were a few times in all those years growing up where we did experience some heckling from some other neighborhood kids on the way home. In the same way, the companions on the way to Emmaus had safety in making the journey together.

As Jesus walked with them, he wasn't recognized as the friend that he was. It always strikes me as odd and hard to understand... Jesus is radically the same and radically different after the resurrection. He always is who he is. There is no experience for us that is comparable for us to better understand... and as they walk, they talk.

A CONVERSATION ABOUT FAITH AND EXPECTATIONS

The most important part of this entire scene is that they talked. The real-ness and the raw-ness of the conversation is of immense help to us today. The disciples began by looking downcast and expressing their own sadness and disappointment... This Jesus they were talking about hadn't fulfilled their expectations. He was supposed to be the Savior of Israel... which in their minds meant that Jesus was to liberate them from the political influence of the Romans in addition to whatever would improve their position with God spiritually. The savior was supposed to be a fulfillment of the covenant between God and his people... Jesus didn't live up to their expectations.

When Jesus had the opportunity to speak, he shares that God's plan did indeed fulfill the covenant... just not their expectations. Jesus became the fulfillment, the conqueror of sin and death, and the reigning king of all of creation. Jesus's sacrifice - his death - was not a mistake, and Jesus's resurrection was promised and is real!

IN OUR HOUSE CHURCHES - SHARING FAITH

Perhaps for us, we find ourselves in a place of sadness and disappointment...Perhaps we find ourselves experiencing difficulty due to the social distancing and public health measures...Perhaps the 'excitement of newness' has worn off...Perhaps our desire for being in our church buildings and receiving the Eucharist and experiencing our community of faith physically present together causes you pain and suffering... For us too, expressing to Jesus the real-ness and raw-ness of our reality and expectations allows him to walk with us and talk with us.

Perhaps I can offer a challenge for this week: Share with someone in your house or family or a good friend how you feel best able to speak to God... to say what you want... what your heart wants to say or express... and how you feel that God speaks or communicates with you in return. It might seem a little scary or make us a little nervous about what someone else might say... but remember that our faith is strengthened as it is shared... and the ones with whom we share it do love and care for us.

KNOW THAT OUR PRAYER UNITES US A COMMUNITY

We've been using Facebook and Flocknote to try and get our ongoing communications out. I certainly feel the community present for Sunday Mass on Facebook Live. I long for us to be together in our church buildings again. We love you and we pray for you. Thank you for your prayers and ongoing support.
