





About the Mass

The Catholic Church has a set of guidelines that set principles for the celebration of the Mass. These guidelines are called the General Instruction of the Roman Missal (GIRM). These principles are set down by the tradition of the Church and the theology of the Liturgy the Church holds to.All of these are not set as a sort of rigid legalism but are meant to be the basis in which we as the Church promote conscious, full and active participation of all the faithful. The actions and movement of the Mass then is not decided by an individual priest or preferences but by the tradition of the Church

This is the goal of Liturgical celebration; to participate actively in the saving work of Jesus Christ. This doesn't just mean singing along with hymns, though that is good to do. This is more speaking of the question; "Am I lifting my soul to God." In the preface dialogue we hear the priest say "Lift up your hearts." To which we respond. "We lift them up to the Lord." Active participation in the Mass is when this response can be said with certainty and truth.

We are participating in Christ's Sacrifice. The importance of this cannot be understated. The Mass and our Sunday Worship is primarily about uniting myself to Jesus' sacrifice. In this way, my entire week can be united to this one Mass on Sunday (or daily Mass) insomuch as I unite my works, joys, suffering and everything to the Sacrifice that Jesus made on Calvary in which we enter into at the celebration of Mass.

With that said...We begin every Mass with the Sign of the Cross; because it is from the Cross that gives meaning to the entirety of the Mass and our Faith.
