Parents: this camp is designed for those who will be freshman or sophomore this fall, a very vulnerable and changing time in their lives, where they are looking for answers and guidance in making good moral decisions. Nothing or no one can take the place of a parent guiding and instilling good moral values in their children's lives. This camp gives them an opportunity to develop a support system to help them live out those values. Being Christian is not just something we do on Sundays but should be practiced in our lives every day. These ideals are shared at camp with practical ways of applying them to our families, at home, at school, at church, on the basketball court or ball field, and many other places, learning with their friends and making new friends. These goals are achieved through the talks given throughout the week by the spiritual director, adult and junior counselors. 
