#### KNOW YOUR FAITH

Join Fr. Sund each week for a short lesson on faith!

The Mass - Part 5: The Collect



After the Gloria, the priest will say "Let us Pray". This is also referred to as the "Opening Prayer". However, I believe "collect" gives a more apt description of what is taking place. The Collect is meant to be a time in which we direct our minds, hearts and intentions.. we take time to collect ourselves.

These prayers our composed with a beauty that often expresses a theme of the Gospel that day, a theme of the liturgical season we are in, or recalls the Saint we are celebrating that day. These prayers are usually addressed to God the Father. Most often they follow a formulation that I refer to through a shortcut as "You – Who – Do - Through". I'll explain each of those elements.

You: Addressing the Father. Usually "Almighty Father", "Good and gracious God" or something similar.

Who: This part of the prayer recalls a great act of salvation history. Recalling what God has done.

<u>Do</u>: Usually begins "grant that". We are asking in petition that the Lord continue his great work in us.

<u>Through:</u> As Christians our prayers are prayed "Through Christ Our Lord."

Not only is this a good way to listen to the prayers at Mass. But it is also a good way to say a prayer when we our asked to lead a prayer in a group! Next week we will enter into the Liturgy of the Word.
