Dear parishioners,

I've decided to start allowing my inner St. Paul to come to the surface again. I will be writing letters for the bulletin. Mine won't ever be considered part of sacred revelation, but hopefully they will be helpful.

I want to start with the topic of two-fers. We are beginning the season when we are the most hopeful of being offered two-fers. There are times when we are blessed in this way. This was the case this past weekend in our family of parishes. We had the Anointing of the Sick for those who were seriously ill and for those over 65 years old. You received two sacraments in one Mass, two-fers. Many of you will be attending a wedding this summer. You will inevitably be wondering if the wedding Mass will count for your Sunday Mass obligation. It doesn't. No two-fers. Why not?

God commands us to make Sunday a day of the Lord. He doesn't just suggest it. So, our Saturday evening and Sunday Masses are focused on Him. He is the King and has the right to expect that from us. Weddings are for the bride and the groom. We often have a Mass as a part of the ceremony, but our focus is on the wedding. For this reason, priests cannot replace a weekend Mass with a wedding Mass. On very rare occasions, a couple may have their marriage blessed at a Sunday Mass, but the prayers and readings are still for the Lord's day, not wedding readings and prayers for the couple. It is the same with a funeral. The prayers at a funeral Mass are for the deceased and not focused on worshipping the King.

Over the years, I have explained this concept many times. It seldom works. Most people still believe they should be able to count a weekend wedding or funeral as their Sunday obligation Mass. They want two-fers. The only thing that everyone seems to understand is the additional question I ask when this comes up: was there a collection? If there was not a collection it certainly wasn't a Sunday Mass. Oddly enough, the collection has nothing to do with it, but that is what most people understand.

This week we have another day when this question comes up, the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. In Nebraska, this is a Holy Day of Mass obligation. Apart from Nebraska most areas of the United States move the celebration of this feast to the following Sunday, so most of the country gets two-fers next Sunday. We don't. We are required to attend Mass on Wednesday evening or Thursday this week and also go to Mass next Sunday. Some "faithful Catholics" ignore this, fearing that they will overdose on holiness or out of jealousy of those other Catholics receiving two-fers. Just remember, your reward will be great in heaven. Don't miss out on that extra bonus grace.

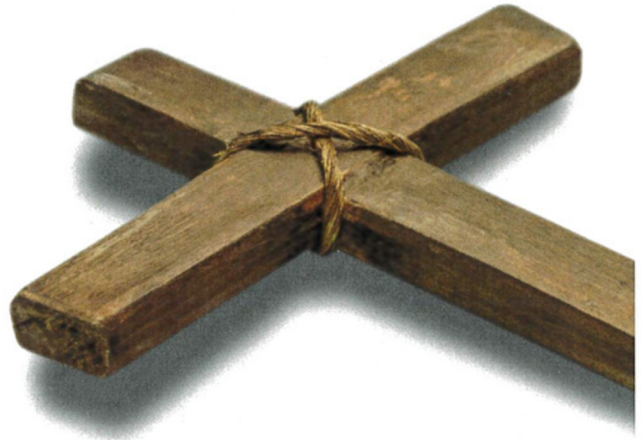
