Journey of Faith progress update

Decree of Merger of five northern parishes into Annunciation Parish

By decree of His Excellency George J. Lucas, and in accord with canons 515, §2 and 121 of the Code of Canon Law, and in consultation with the Archdiocese of Omaha Council of Priests according to the norm of law (canons 515 §2 and 127), St. John the Baptist Parish in Deloit, St. Peter de Alcantara Parish in Ewing, St. Theresa Parish in Clearwater, St. Francis of Assisi Parish in Neligh, and Our Lady of Mount Carmel Parish in Tilden are suppressed and the new parish, Annunciation of the Blessed Virgin Mary Parish, is erected, effective July 1, 2024 with a concern for the care of souls and to ensure the vitality of parish life in the area.

What is a transitional deacon?

The deacons we usually see are "permanent" deacons. Often, these men are married and will always be deacons.

A man who is on his way to being ordained a priest will be ordained a transitional deacon and serve in the deacon role for approximately one year. This time allows for him to practice service as an ordained man. He can baptize children, witness marriages, and bury the dead. He can assist & preach at Mass, along with many other duties. Please pray for the three transitional deacons within our Archdiocese as they take their final steps toward priesthood.
