



transitional deacon. So, what is a transitional deacon? The deacons we usually see are "permanent" deacons. Often, these men are married and will always be deacons. A man who is on his way to being ordained a priest will be ordained a transitional deacon and serve in the role of deacon for approximately one year. This time allows for the man to practice service as an ordained man. He can baptize children, witness marriages, and bury the dead. He can assist and preach at Mass, along with many other duties. I ask for your prayers for the new Deacon Zach Eischeid as he takes this final step torwards priesthood.

After searching for the perfect kneeler to match the architecture of St. Boniface Church, an original piece when the church was built was found in the Rectory office attic. After a tedious cleanup, getting the wood to its original state and a prayer in calligraphy, hand written by an Elginite, Laurie Zvodsky, is attached to front of the Mary Altar, for praying for time, for any vocation!
