Let us celebrate the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist - Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity

The Eucharist is the source and summit of our Catholic Faith.

The Real Presence happens through the change which the Church calls transubstantiation (change of substance).

At the Consecration of the Mass, the priest says the words which Christ Himself pronounced over bread and wine,

"This is My Body," "This is the chalice of My Blood," "Do this in memory of me",

and by the power of the Holy Spirit, ordinary bread and wine is changed into the Real Presence of Jesus Christ.

Journey of Faith progress update

Decree of Merger of five northern parishes into Annunciation Parish

By decree of His Excellency George J. Lucas, and in accord with canons 515, §2 and 121 of the Code of Canon Law, and in consultation with the Archdiocese of Omaha Council of Priests according to the norm of law (canons 515 §2 and 127), St. John the Baptist Parish in Deloit, St. Peter de Alcantara Parish in Ewing, St. Theresa Parish in Clearwater, St. Francis of Assisi Parish in Neligh, and Our Lady of Mount Carmel Parish in Tilden are suppressed and the new parish, Annunciation of the Blessed Virgin Mary Parish, is erected, effective July 1, 2024 with a concern for the care of souls and to ensure the vitality of parish life in the area.

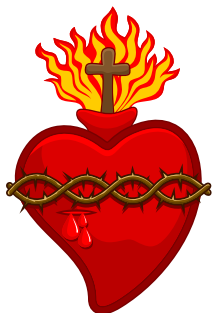

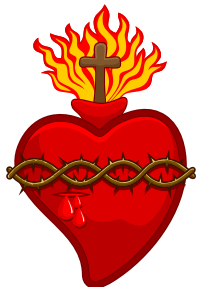

The National Eucharistic Revival will oversee the blessing of a nation with 4 Eucharistic Procession Pilgrimages, forming a cross over the country. The Serra Route will pass through Nebraska and Iowa June 12-25, 2024. Spirit Catholic Radio will highlight this historic Pilgrimage by airing a Mass, providing updates along the route, and having interviews on Spirit Mornings (heard 7-9am, Mon-Fri). Three Pilgrimage stops will feature the Vatican Approved Eucharistic Miracles Display designed by Bl.
