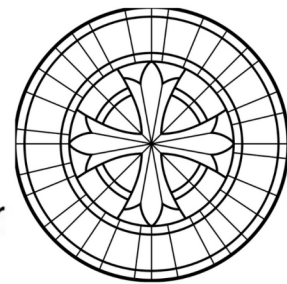

Dear Parishoners,

I would like to speak a little bit about the custom and practice of entrusting one of our loved ones to the mercy and love of God through the offering of mass intentions. It is a good thing to offer mass intentions for those we care about and love, living and deceased.

The universal Church wants us to offer this service and ministry to our parishioners, and I am very grateful to Linda Moser, Helen Larson, and Kelly Starman for their work in coordinating and scheduling the intentions.

On the practical side of things, we will follow these guidelines for mass intention requests:

- One Mass will be reserved each month for the six parishes as a memorial mass for those who have died in the past month from our six parishes. This mass will rotate locations.
- Each Mass will only have one intention. The intention may be for multiple related individuals. This means that a Mass may be said for "Joseph Norman" or "Joseph and Joan Norman" or "Joseph, Joan, Dan, Chris, and Kay Norman" or "the Joseph Norman family" or "Frank Smith and Jane Smith Doe (his daughter)".

We will accept any and all mass intentions that we can, however the following norms will be followed for scheduling Masses onsite:

- Any one family can request up to 3 Mass intentions onsite per calendar year.
- In addition, we will only schedule up to 12 Masses for any one intention in a calendar year, eg. 12 Masses for "Joseph Norman". Sometime multiple families request the same intention.
- We will not schedule a single intention for the same date or day of the month, eg. "the 5th of the month" or "First Friday of the month".
- Any *newly received* Mass intentions that cannot be scheduled onsite within our parishes during the calendar year will be transferred to another site (eg. Office of Propagation of the Faith for Retired Clergy or Mt. Michael Benedictine Abbey or another priest) who will fulfill the Mass intention(s) within a year of the request. The most important thing in offering a Mass intention is that the Mass be said, regardless of when or where or if you can be present. This time designation is governed by Catholic Church's Code of Canon Law and Archdiocese of Omaha Policy.
- All Mass intentions that have already received by the parishes will be fulfilled in a manner that is as consistent as possible with the expectations that people felt when requesting the mass intentions.
- We will move to have the mass intentions already received across the six parishes to be scheduled in these next months or sent to another religious entity to make sure that the intentions are honored and fulfilled with expediency.
- Finally, the suggested donation for a Mass intention in the Archdiocese of Omaha is \$10. This is strictly an offering and not a fee. A Mass intention will not be refused if someone is unable to make the suggested donation. Larger donations are at the discretion of the giver, but a larger donation does not give any higher priority to the scheduling of the Mass intention.
- If a Mass intention is requested, then the Mass will be said. It may not be said at the particular Mass date or time that one would prefer and it may not be in your church or within our six parishes. Nevertheless, the Church offers this service so that we can entrust those we love in a special way to the sacrifice of the Mass.

We are encouraged to pray at all times without ceasing, and this is one way that we do that.

## KNOW YOUR FAITH

### Part 6: Silence at Mass



The Mass gives special instructions for silence. In many places in the Missal, the priest is directed to observe a brief time of silence. Some of the particular times include, but are not limited to: the time before the Penitential Act, before the Opening Prayer (after Father says "Let us Pray"), and after the reception of Holy Communion. These periods are meant to be a time to recollect ourselves and focus our attention to prayer.

St. Teresa of Calcutta (Mother Teresa) said "In the silence of the heart, God speaks." The Mass is meant to give us this moment, this holy time for God to speak to our hearts. When the priest then observes silence at these times during Mass, it is a reminder for us to take that time to listen for God. This can be done with a formal prayer (such as the Anima Christi) or in a simple silence.

At some more solemn occasions of the year, such as Good Friday, the Church observes a more grand silence. This is also meant to be a prayerful silence that guides us to meditate upon the death of Christ that is before us on that Good Friday. That can be used as an example for the quiet we are meant to keep in our hearts each Mass. (I'm not saying we have to leave Mass in eerie silence -- but that the period after receiving communion should have this spirit). This also stresses the importance of remaining in Mass until the final blessing. (The end of Mass) For if it is silence that allows the Lord to speak to our hearts, we should want to spend as long as we can with him; especially in those moments that he has entered our heart! Next week we will begin exploring the Liturgy of the Word!
