## KNOW YOUR FAITH

### Part 6: Liturgy of the Words

The Mass is divided into two main parts.

The Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist. The Liturgy of the Word (on Sundays) consists of the First Reading, a Responsorial Psalm, the Second Reading, the Gospel, the Homily, the Profession of Faith and the Prayers of the Faithful. The central focus of the Liturgy of the Word is the Gospel as it is the proclamation of the message of Jesus Christ. The Homily is not the central point of the Mass, or even of the first part of the Mass but only serves to help the Word of God be more richly received.

The Liturgy of the Word has a three part cycle of Readings. They are simply named "Year A, B and C". These cycles are meant to give us a wide array of readings from Scripture and end up covering a large majority of the scriptures during the context of a three year period. This allows for us as Catholics to have a living knowledge of Scripture in our lives.

The Responsorial Psalm is part of the Liturgy that builds off of the First Reading. If you pay close attention to the Psalm and the Reading there is often a central theme repeated. The Psalms were written by King David and often recall the very events of our faith that are expressed in the Old Testament readings. King David wrote these as a sung music and so we most fittingly sing the Psalms. The Psalms hold the greatest place of any song in the Church. No hymn composed, however great can ever be greater because the Psalms themselves are the inspired Word of God.
