



Excerpt of the Litany of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

Eleventh Sunday of Ordinary Time

June 13, 2021



FRIDAY JUNE 11TH CELEBRATED THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS Nothing says I love you like the Friday after the second Sunday after Easter, right? In our church calendar, this is the day on which we celebrate the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

This devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is a way of trying to fathom or better comprehend the love of God. Jesus' heart is seen ablaze with the unconditional, deep, impassioned love for us... for each of us and for all of us. Jesus, being fully both God and man, makes the invisible God visible to us. In moments like these, we also see God – divinity – shine through humanity. The unlimited God makes himself seen in a moment constrained by humanity's own limitation.

Love is something that we could never run out of words trying to describe. Love is meant to be freely given from one person to another... and then love invites a response in return. Love cannot be coerced, only invited. In our human weakness, we struggle to offer unconditional love and we struggle to offer love freely. Being wounded by sin, we often feel safer when we have rules and conditions for affection, when we have a feeling of control or 'being owed' or duty yielding affection. A mindset of transaction is safer than an anticipation of a freely given gift.

On this feast day, we are reminded of the truth that God... that Jesus... loves us without these controls or conditions. He both makes a sacrifice of himself and becomes vulnerable in his gift of self. St. Thomas Aquinas defines love as "willing the good for the other." While this may sound like a sterile definition, it captures the truth of God not having an ulterior motive in his love.

Our God... the God of the universe... makes a claim through this image that each of us is lovable, worthy of love, and intensely loved by him. The following litany names the completeness of God's love in sacrifice and affection for us and his seeking of us.

Heart of Jesus, Son of the Eternal Father, have mercy on us. Heart of Jesus, formed by the Holy Spirit in the womb of the Virgin Mother, Heart of Jesus, substantially united to the Word of God, Heart of Jesus, of Infinite Majesty, Heart of Jesus, Sacred Temple of God, Heart of Jesus, Tabernacle of the Most High, Heart of Jesus, House of God and Gate of Heaven, Heart of Jesus, burning furnace of charity, Heart of Jesus, abode of justice and love, Heart of Jesus, full of goodness and love, Heart of Jesus, abyss of all virtues, Heart of Jesus, most worthy of all praise, Heart of Jesus, king and center of all hearts, Heart of Jesus, in whom are all treasures of wisdom and knowledge, Heart of Jesus, in whom dwells the fullness of divinity, Heart of Jesus, in whom the Father was well pleased, Heart of Jesus, of whose fullness we have all received, Heart of Jesus, desire of the everlasting hills, Heart of Jesus, patient and most merciful, Heart of Jesus, enriching all who invoke Thee, Heart of Jesus, fountain of life and holiness, Heart of Jesus, propitiation for our sins, Heart of Jesus, loaded down with opprobrium, Heart of Jesus, bruised for our offenses, Heart of Jesus, obedient to death, Heart of Jesus, pierced with a lance, Heart of Jesus, source of all consolation, Heart of Jesus, our life and resurrection, Heart of Jesus, our peace and our reconciliation, Heart of Jesus, victim for our sins Heart of Jesus, salvation of those who trust in Thee,




