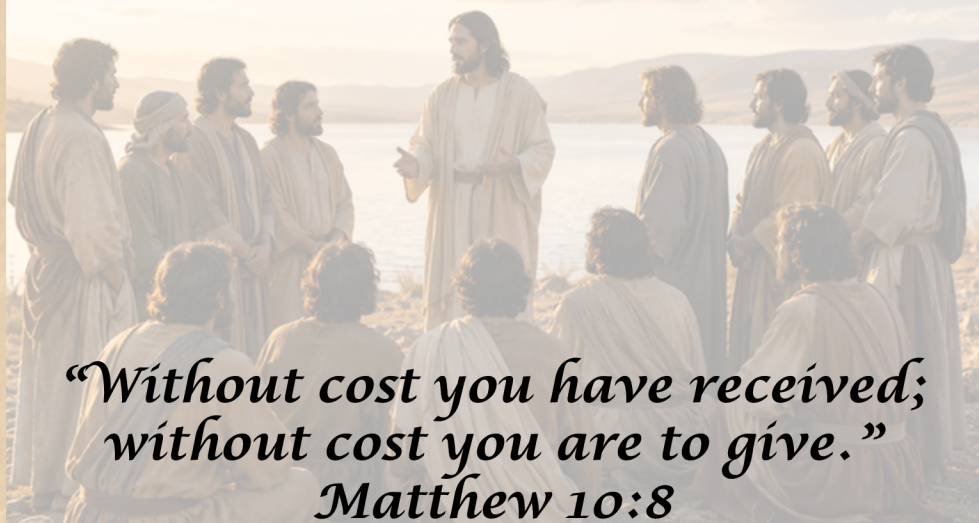


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11th Sunday of Ordinary Time

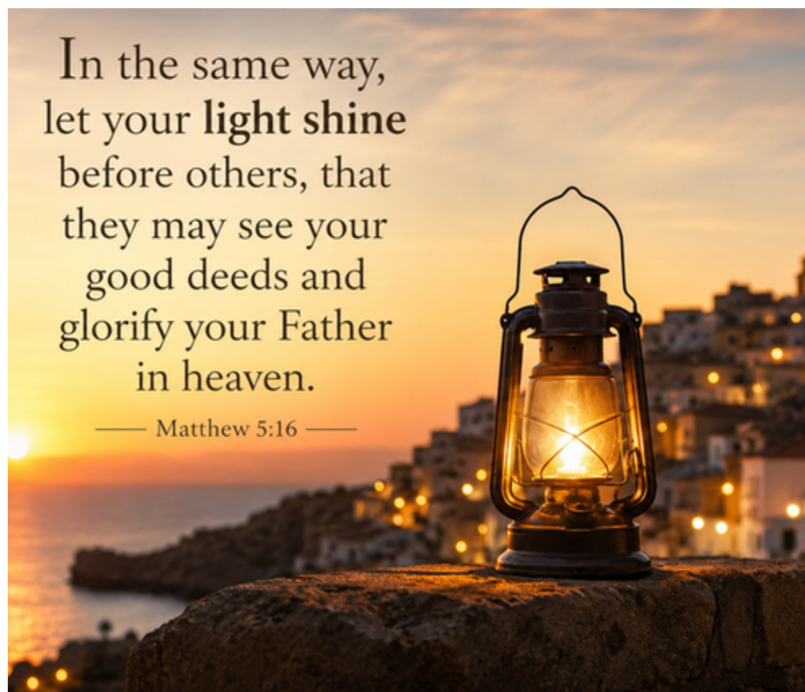

From the Desk of Father Frank



Dear Parishioners,

Over the past few weeks, I have been trying to keep you up to date with the changes that are going to happen with priests for your parishes. I've had a couple letters and a couple homilies. The problem with the homilies is that I only do half the parishes each week. Some of you have not received all that information. The past two weeks have been perfect for dealing with this topic. Two weeks ago, was Trinity Sunday. Last week was Corpus Christi Sunday. The first helps us realize that God's work comes to us in three ways. The second specifically emphasizes the work of Jesus. This is important for us to have a full picture of what impact this can have on our spiritual lives.

Last week we had the valid ordination for Fr. Michael Figura. I add the emphasis on valid because we have many who call themselves priests but are not validly in the succession from Jesus, through the apostles and their successors. Without this validity, it is like me trying to take money out of your bank account without a valid signature. God is picky about who can work with specific kinds of His grace. Giving absolution is an example of this.

The work of the priest at Mass is not just to make sure everyone can receive communion. Contrary to what most people think, this is secondary. The priest is there to offer sacrifice. This is like the Levite priests in the Old Testament. Only they could offer the sacrifices in thanksgiving and to atone for sins. The Catholic priest starts out offering the simple and almost ridiculous gifts of bread and wine. But by the authority of Jesus, they become the Body and Blood of Christ. That is what the priest offers to God. It is the only offering that is worthy of God the Father's consideration. Because He is pleased with this offering, He offers it back to us to receive in communion so that we can have eternal life with Him. To keep this working validly is the work of the Holy Spirit, who guides the church, so we don't stray from the rules of this plan. All of this is the work of the validly ordained priest. Notice that I don't say, the most effective priest. Some of us have our human faults, but the work of the Trinity continues.

I have been talking about this because there is a history of people making bad decisions when they don't feel the priest is right for them. They might decide to join another Christian denomination, go to Mass on TV, or just cancel Mass from their faith journey. In differing degrees, all of these are problematic, because they are deviations from what Jesus told us to do. He is the one whom the Father sent to make sure we knew what to do to please Him. I hope that the current changes do not cause any more poor decisions. We have had plenty of them in the past, we don't need more.

Next week I will try to answer another question that keeps coming up. Why doesn't the Lincoln Diocese help by sending some of their priests, since we are so short?
