Heavenly Father, Thank You for the gift of our spiritual fathers, our priests!

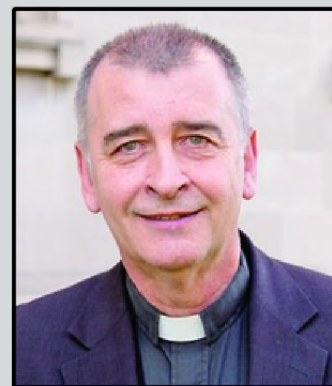

Journey of Faith progress update

By decree of His Excellency George J. Lucas, the decree of May 15, 2024 is emended in order to more clearly articulate the reasons for the merger of St. John the Baptist Parish in Deloit, St. Peter de Alcantara Parish in Ewing, St. Theresa Parish in Clearwater, St. Francis of Assisi Parish in Neligh, and Our Lady of Mount Carmel Parish in Tilden, by which the new parish, Annunciation of the Blessed Virgin Mary Parish, is erected, and to more accurately explain the process for redress. The decree is posted in each of the effected churches. The merger of St. John the Baptist Parish in Deloit, St. Peter de Alcantara Parish in Ewing, St. Theresa Parish in Clearwater, St. Francis of Assisi Parish in Neligh, and Our Lady of Mount Carmel Parish in Tilden and erection of Annunciation of the Blessed Virgin Mary Parish becomes effective July 1, 2024

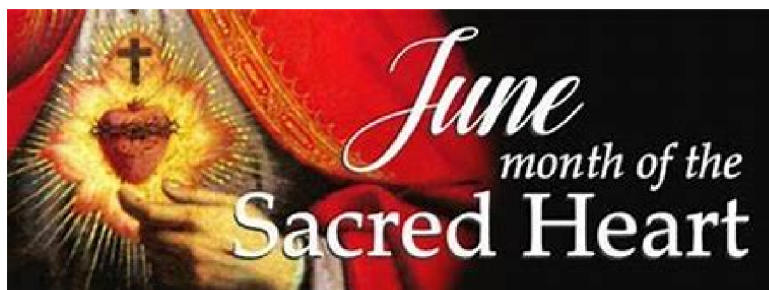
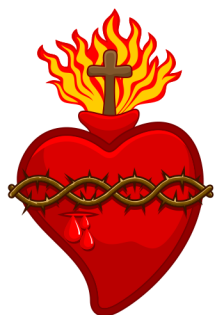

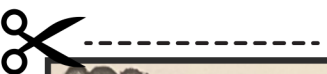
