

#### **KNOW YOUR FAITH**

#### Walking Through Mass The Gospel

The proclamation of the Gospel is the highest point of the Liturgy of the Word. This is shown in multiple ways. First, the one who always proclaims the Gospel is an ordained priest or deacon. This is because in a special way their lives have been consecrated for preaching and teaching the Gospel. We stand and sing in acclamation the Alleluia as the Gospel is in procession. The Candles follow and often incense is also used to give honor to the Gospels.

If this were "just a book" the amount of honor we pay it would seem crazy. We believe, however, that this book is truly the inspired Word of God and the proclamation of the salvation of Jesus Christ. It is the "Good News." We truly believe that Jesus Christ is present among us through the proclamation of the Word. This is the reason we give such a high reverence.

The Gospel is read or even sometimes sung or chanted. As the priest or deacon announces "A Reading from the Holy Gospel according to..." he traces the sign of the cross over the page of the Gospel book. He then, with the people crosses his forehead, lips and chest. The symbolism of this is that the Lord may make his Word present in our minds, on our lips, and in our heart.
