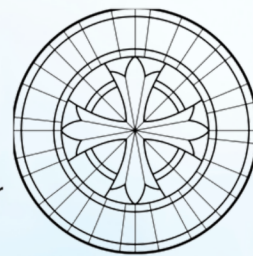

KNOW YOUR FAITH

The Mass - Part 8: "The Creed"



After the Homily has been completed, we stand as one body and profess our faith. Creed comes from the Latin word "credo" which simply means "I believe". The exact creed we say at most Sunday Masses is named the "Niceno-Constantinopolitan Creed" or just "Nicene Creed" for short.

This creed is common between both East and West and was agreed on at the ecumenical or church council in 325 and 381 respectively. At these councils, the bishops of the Church saw a need to name down what it was that we believe. There had been many heresies that denied the divinity of Christ, denied that he was truly man or denied the divinity of the Holy Spirit.

This great creed then was mandated to be spoken at all churches so that the faithful would know if they were in communion with Rome, the one, true Church.

If anyone ever asks you what you believe as a Catholic, the creed is the best place to start. With the new translation in 2011, there has been one word that became difficult for some. "Consubstantial" This word is stating that the Father and the Son are of the same substance. (A term in Aristotelian philosophy). The previous translation said "one in being..." We are speaking of the fact that he is one God and three persons.

In the creed, we also make a profound bow at the mention that Jesus "by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary and became man." This is a sign of reverence for the incarnation in which the World became Flesh.

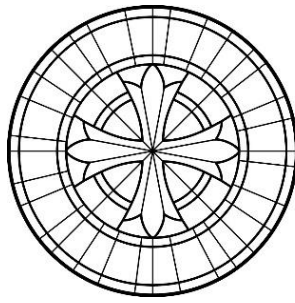

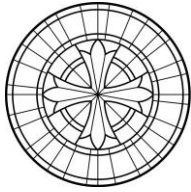

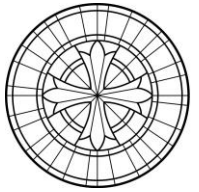
