

Missionary Benedictines Sisters

Celebrating 100 Years in the USA


July 30, 2023 Mass & Lunch 10:30am St. Bonaventure's, Raeville, Nebraska On July 31, 1923, a sapling was planted by four Missionary Benedictine Sisters of Tutzing, Germany. They had been invited to Nebraska by Archbishop Jeremiah Harty of Omaha to minister to German immigrants. The fall of 1923 the Sisters began teaching in St. John Berchman's School, Raeville, Nebraska.

The small community quickly began to sink its roots and grow. Within one year, a second mission, Sacred Heart Hospital in Lynch, Nebraska. In 1926, Raeville gained status as a priory, with Sr. Diemud Gerber, OSB, as the first prioress.

The Sisters opened Our Lady of Lourdes Hospital in Norfolk, Nebraska, in 1935. In 1940, the priory center was transferred to Norfolk and named Immaculata Convent. Through the needs of the Church and the changing talents of the community, the Spirit continues to call for adaptations in their ministries.



KNOW YOUR FAITH





After the Creed has been professed we enter into what is formally known as the "General Intercessions", You may also hear it referred to as the Prayers of the Faithful or the petitions. These prayers are meant to conclude the Liturgy of the Word and gather our intentions toward the altar. The Eucharistic Sacrifice of Christ is offered as an intercession for the living and dead.

The people gathered, with the priest, make an offering of the Mass. This means that our own intentions are to be offered together with the Sacrifice of Christ on the altar. Ordinarily, these prayers are done in a petition response form in which we respond: "Lord hear Our Prayer". The Church always prays in Mass for the following needs: those of the Church, those in public authority, needs of the local community, and those burdened by difficulty. In addition, most parishes will also use this as a time to make known the priest's intention of the Mass. (eg "For the repose of the soul of n, for who this Mass is offered.) This time is meant to call us again into full and active participation in which our very lives, our cares, and our burdens are brought upon the altar before our Lord. If people have asked you to pray for them or their loved ones, this is the best time to call those prayers into mind. There is no better moment to pray for people than united with the Mass! -- This concludes the Liturgy of the Word
