



Know YOUR Faith

Join Fr. Sund weekly for a lesson in faith



Is it EVER okay to miss Sunday Mass?

The third commandment requires of us to keep holy the Sabbath day. For us as Christians, this means attending Mass on Sunday (or Saturday evening). The Church teaches that if I fail to attend Mass any Sunday or Holy Day of Obligation on purpose, I have committed a mortal sin and should not receive the Eucharist until I have gone to the Sacrament of Confession.

Understandably, we can find ourselves in difficult situations unable to get to Mas at times. -- I wish to draw out a few situations of examples to show what breaks this commandment and what doesn't.

- An 85 year old woman looks outside on a Sunday morning. A sheet of ice has covered the streets. She decides for her safety not to go to Mass as she is prone to falls. Health is the limitation here. The woman is physically unable to go to Mass. (The same would apply if someone is badly ill) She has not sinned.
- A young child is sick with the flu. One of the parents stays home to care for them and is unable to find a Mass to attend. The illness of a small child extends to parents as they have to care for them. Also, the parents caring for the child may also be carrying the flu virus. This is not a sin.
- A young high school student has a volleyball tournament on Sunday morning. She is unable to make it to Mass. This is a sin. Furthermore, the adults scheduling the volleyball tournament, and the parents that signed them up, even if they themselves make it to Mass, have also sinned mortally in leading children into mortal sin.
- A family of five is traveling across the Ozarks. There
 are very few Catholic Churches in the area. They do
 not do any prior planning and miss Sunday Mass. This
 is breaking the third commandment, when traveling,
 even on cruises, we must always put the attendance of
 Mass on Sunday in our travel plans!

We should make our best efforts to make Mass on Sunday and to keep Sunday Holy and free from unnecessary work. If we purposefully miss Mass we must go to the Sacrament of Confession before receiving the Eucharist.

Missionary Benedictines Sisters

Celebrating 100 Years in the USA

July 30, 2023 Mass & Lunch 10:30am St. Bonaventure's, Raeville, Nebraska On July 31, 1923, a sapling was planted by four Missionary Benedictine Sisters of Tutzing, Germany. They had been invited to Nebraska by Archbishop Jeremiah Harty of Omaha to minister to German immigrants. The fall of 1923 the Sisters began teaching in St. John Berchman's School, Raeville,

The small community quickly began to sink its roots and grow. Within one year, a second mission, Sacred Heart Hospital in Lynch, Nebraska. In 1926, Raeville gained status as a priory, with Sr. Diemud Gerber, OSB, as the first prioress. The Sisters opened Our Lady of Lourdes Hospital in Norfolk, Nebraska, in 1935. In 1940, the priory center was transferred to Norfolk and named Immaculata Convent. Through the needs of the Church and the changing talents of the community, the Spirit continues to call for adaptations in their ministries.
