#### SO... WHY ARE WE HERE?

I think it's helpful to have a moment of reflection as we enter into this <u>third year</u> of our new pastoral arrangement. In 2019, we started this adventure of two priests and six parishes. This has often felt like a map with no labels. The archdiocese defined us a "parish grouping" and we changed our language to a "family of parishes" to better represent our reality. This model was adopted in place of a plan that drastically reduced the number of "open" and active faith communities.

#### A CHANGE FROM MANAGING TO SUPPORTING

The plan that the Archdiocese announced and later discarded was based on criteria that tried to approximate "how much can a single priest manage?" A 2011 priest demographic report from CARA at Georgetown for the Archdiocese of Omaha shows the extent to which we project fewer priests will be available for ministry as larger classes of priests reach our retirement age of 70 and younger ordination classes (like mine!) are much smaller. The idea of managing that we've inherited in our parishes often expects that the priest is at the center of everything that happens. This tends to have us presume that everything happens because 'Father' does it... that 'Father' provides programs and services to which we subscribe or patronize. Certainly there are pastoral leadership, administrative, and spiritual roles that are proper or necessary for clergy and staff to fulfill... and the requirements for these change over time... but sometimes the ways in which we have said things or communicated in the past expresses an attitude of "Father manages all the details, programs, and pieces of our game plan to get to heaven."

In acknowledging and accompanying us through the challenges of our 21<sup>st</sup> Century context, one thematic area of change the Archdiocese is currently coaching me around can be summarized this way: Let the buildings be *managed* but let your parishioners and households of faith be *supported*.

SUPPORTING AND BEING SUPPORTED This model of a priest team supporting several distinct parishes borrows from both new things and old things. Sometimes without having done it this way before, we try and describe what will this be like.

Some of the older images from the history books can help us see the different concepts that are being put together. Travel is one area. In the old days of the circuit riders, priests would travel from community to community to offer Mass and provide sacraments. He would go to the community because there were believers there and he supported them as he could. The community of believers continued to practice their faith between visits. Most of the community's faith life was lived out without the priest being immediately present. In our context, we are able to provide a weekend Mass at every church to support our communities of believers. My car's odometer tells me that I drove almost 35,000 miles over the last 12 months (obviously not all of that mileage being church driving... but a lot of it was). Our expectations around what requires a priest's presence will need to be more like a circuit rider and less like a resident pastor of a single church.

One of the ways that I have been supported in my role as pastor is by relying on a pastoral leadership team (PLT) made up of Fr. Vogel and several lay members. This group gathers with me regularly to prayerfully discern, consider, and promote the focus and priorities of our pastoral and spiritual care in our communities. The Archdiocese of Omaha Parish Support Team has helped us put together this group as they promote models of collaborative leadership in all the parishes of the Archdiocese. The group has certainly helped us generate better ideas and plans than if I had worked alone.

This is where parish leadership becomes more important rather than less important. I will be relying on the parish councils of each parish more than in the past. Some councils are currently active, some have taken a break, and some need rehabilitation. In each parish community, I see the parish councils taking a very active role in making sure that our churches, buildings, and spaces are managed in a way that supports our mission of gathering as a parish family and faith community. Our meetings and decisions will help us determine and discern what to do with what we have. Our diversity of mass times in different churches makes some parish customs of elections more difficult. As a simplification, the parish council positions will be done as pastor appointments, relying on local parish recommendations. Each of the six parishes will get focused attention on this group over the next year. Please pray for a year of spiritual fruitfulness as we continue to grow and mature as communities of faith.




