

From the Desk of Father Frank



Dear parishioners,

Last week I mentioned that God will not connect with us in the same way as he did the first time. Think in terms of dating and marriage and you have a part of the answer. Couples must adjust their connection with each other every few years, if not more. Even though they may still hold hands or give each other a kiss throughout their marriage, there are other things that change. Needs change. Their bodies and health change. They know each other better. Hopefully, they will still show their love, but in different ways.

There was a movie called Romancing the Stone. In it two people fell passionately in love. There was a sequel, The Jewel of the Nile. That movie started when the romance was over. They had to adjust. I've seen shows about how a person puts a spell on a person to make them love them. It worked. After a while, the passionate love that seemed to be so important, became very irritating. God is no different. With some people he starts with what feels like a very passionate connection. If he continued that throughout the person's life, it would start to be weird.

He first linked with me as a creator to a boy. Over time that evolved into a working relationship. He then herded me into priesthood. For 47 years I have wanted to serve him, and he has continued to give me opportunities to do that. But even within that framework, things have changed. I became very comfortable in my service to him. Sometimes it just started to feel like a job, or a boss and employee relationship. It seemed to be enough for me, but it wasn't for God. He challenged me by giving me greater challenges. I noticed. My response was a question, "Am I your slave?" His response, "Figure it out." Luckily, I already had a tool by which to do that. My priest's prayerbook is filled with scripture. The answers started to come to me as I prayed those scriptures. Yes, I am his servant, but he wants more than that. Mary was his handmaid, but she was also a loving mother to his son. I am a worker in his vineyard, but I am also a father who needs to be taking care of the real Father's children. To do that well, I must love them. That is different than a job. Most people don't think about loving their customers, but most people do think about loving their children. Along with that, God has spiced up that relationship with me by adding humor and beauty. I am a collector of pictures of sunrises and sunsets that he has shown me. He also throws in an occasional crazy humorous moment to keep me out of the strictly servant role.

God is trying to have a personal connection with each of us. If we are blocking him or fighting against this during parts of our life, the devil will try to move into that open spot and make a personal connection with us. He wants to figure out how to hook you in your weakest areas. He will then cling to that part of our soul. Next week I may delve into that kind of relationship.

Converging Roads conference


