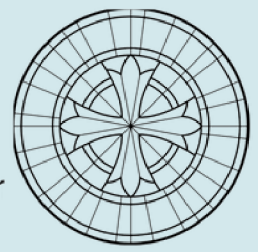

## KNOW YOUR FAITH

Join Fr. Sund each week for a short lesson on faith!



**What does it mean to have contrition?**

We took a month break from Know Your Faith in July, but now that it's August, lets get back to learning!

When we go to confession, we make our Act of Contrition (also known as the prayer of sorrow). What exactly is contrition? The catechism defines contrition as "sorrow of the soul and hatred for sin committed, together with the resolution not to sin again." Contrition is absolutely necessary for forgiveness of sins, for to be forgiven we must resolve to change our lives.

There are two types of contrition. The first is perfect contrition. This is fueled by love of God above all things. Perfect contrition is able to obtain the forgiveness of venial sins. So for example, when I make the act of contrition when I go to bed and I truly am sorry for offending because of my love of God and have resolution not to sin tomorrow, my venial (or smaller) sins are indeed forgiven. (CCC 1452)

Sometimes people mistakenly believe that perfect contrition can be had instead of going to the Sacrament of Confession. If one commits a mortal sin, perfect contrition is able to forgive that sin only when the person has resolution to go to the Sacrament of Confession once they are able. This, however, is not in ordinary circumstances but speaks more of times that we are in great danger of dying and a priest is not available.

Most of us often do not have perfect contrition, however. More often than not, we have what is called imperfect contrition or "attrition". This is our hatred for sin because of how ugly it is in our lives and because the fear that I will suffer eternal punishment because of my sins. The grace given by the Sacrament of Reconciliation brings my attrition to perfect contrition thus Jesus is able to forgive my sins through the priest!

What a great gift confession is!
