Dear parishioners,

Do you or anyone you know think of the word “work” and another nasty four-letter word? Most children start out with that idea. We need to train them to overcome that. It is not easy. Eventually, they realize that there are rewards that come with work. There is a sense of satisfaction, and sometimes it comes with the reward of getting paid.

This is the easiest lesson about the idea of work.

Many of you have been told that marriage involves a lot of work. It is not just a matter of cruising along in an excellent relationship with no cares in the world. That would be a good way to end up unmarried. Often, the work of marriage goes unrewarded. Sometimes there is an immediate reward, but often it feels like the work is going unnoticed and there is no reward. That is a harder lesson to learn.

In our spiritual lives, work is strange, and often we don’t feel like we are getting anywhere. We can feel like we have lost our connection with God. As God and my dad would say, “Your reward will be great in heaven.” But that might be a long time coming. Many people feel that it just isn’t worth the effort. They give up. This is why I have been writing these last letters, and I started this one by outlining the various levels of training required for work. I want you to move away from the idea that this is all about giving us immediate gratification. That might be necessary for potty training, but you all should know how young we are when that is supposed to happen. These other lessons that God has set up for us are more difficult, and immediate gratification is counter-productive to the lesson.

God is trying to help us train to be a part of his royal family in the kingdom of heaven. God knows what that will mean. We only know a little about what it will be like. Like the master said in the parable of the servants, “Well done good and faithful servant. You have done well in small matters. I will give you greater responsibilities. Come and share your master’s joy” (Mt. 25:23). Most of us want to hear God say, “Well done good and faithful servant.” We are not as interested in the part about getting greater responsibilities.

The responsibility of pastors is to coordinate a parish, or parishes, so that they will be a training field for parishioners, in this life but especially in the next, to take on significant responsibilities. This is why we parishes have stewardship drives. Our new archbishop is developing a plan to hold his annual appeal in every parish as usual this year, but with a twist: he plans to make it a stewardship drive for the entire archdiocese. I haven’t seen the full plans, but I’m sure it will involve more than just money, but also time and talent. He is part of God’s training force. Stay tuned.
