Mass Intention Offering

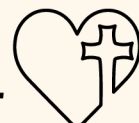

Dear Parishioners of the Catholic Parishes in Partnership,

I have now been here for one month. It has been great. The good news is that my previous time in this area has really been a blessing as I try to figure everything out. The bad news is that time has been flying because it reminds me that I must be getting old. This is because some of the high school students that I knew in those olden days are now having grandchildren. It has been great working with Fr. John and the staff, seeing all the work that they have done to get things set up for this parish family, even though Fr. John left it all to me as he left for vacation. It works out okay, because I leave this Monday evening for three weeks of vacation that I have had planned for a year. I'll be on a cruise ship along the Alaskan coast.

I thought this might be a good chance to answer some of the questions that I have been hearing. First ones are, where I am living and for how long? How long is very simple. I'm hoping for a bunch of years. I'm living at the rectory at St. John's in Petersburg. This has been a real blessing and a reminder of the thought that went into the decision of where things would be for this parish family. Having Fr. John and I in one rectory is really important. With all that is going on, communication is very important. Even being in the same house can be like family life for some of you, in which you might not see each of the family members often enough to know what is going on. There are days when we don't see each other. Having the rectory right across the street from the offices is also very helpful. That has been especially important while Fr. John has been gone. I have my office space in the main parish office building in Petersburg, which used to be St. John's Elementary School, so it is a great use of space! It provides places to meet with people privately and opportunities to connect with different staff members. The other benefit is, the offices are all handicapped accessible, which I have already noticed to be a benefit as I meet with families to prepare for funerals. There are a lot of steps in some of the other rectories, or they don't have the room for all of the staff to do their work and work with each other. As I have had a chance to look at all the other options in these eight parishes, I feel so grateful that this kind of set-up is even possible.

I have also had many comments about how the driving from place to place must be interesting. Oddly enough, I'm not noticing much difference in how much time I am spending in my car. Omaha is spread out. Going from one place to another can easily be a drive of ten to twenty miles, only there are way more traffic lights and construction projects to make trips last a long time. Out here I can drive ten miles and be there in ten minutes. It can take that long to go two miles in Omaha. I did have to deal with a rural traffic jam the other day. I had to wait for four cars and three semis to go by before I could make my turn. You must wait for ten times that at an average traffic light in Omaha.

One other thing that is more of a personal point. Everyone has been very kind out here. I get paranoid that some will kill me with kindness. My family is blessed with better than average health, but I do have family members who have adult on-set diabetes and/or heart problems. For this reason, I try to exercise and eat healthy. I love deserts but really must be careful about having them in the rectory. This combination means that if someone brings a pie, or a plate of cookies, I hear them crying during the night until I eat them. I'm not a cook, so if someone wants to bless me with food, healthy stuff is better.

God bless you all and hopefully my being here will be a blessing for you.
