CHANGE MEANS THINGS DON'T STAY THE SAME SO WHAT CHANGED? THE WORLD AROUND US CHANGED

I know that some people are more interested in the inner organizational elements of the Church than others. Still, I want to share our context. July 1st marked our official change into this new configuration as a parish grouping. Some of the changes and adjustments were related to the configuration, while other changes 'just happened' around the same time.

In January 2019, the Archdiocese Pastoral Planning Office announced these new parish groupings for the rural area of our diocese. Fr. Jeff Lorig took charge of the Planning Office in December 2018, and this changed the method of our planning and implementation. We are designated as six parishes that will be eight parishes within the next five years. We will have one pastor and one associate pastor assigned to the grouping.

Also in January 2019, the Archdiocese Finance Office chose Paycor as our required payroll processor as a way of increasing our reporting compliance under the Affordable Care Act (ACA). The Archdiocese of Omaha exists under civil law as a collection of independent Nebraska non-profit corporations. A corporation exists for each parish, for the central office of the Chancery, and for joint ventures like Pope John XXIII Central Catholic School. At the same time, under the ACA, the Archdiocese of Omaha has a religious

exemption to the Dept of Health and Human Services mandate for insurance plans to cover contraception products or services. This exemption considers the Archdiocese to be considered as an aggregate of all the individual corporations. We were scheduled to implement this new payroll program for our July 15 pay date. Moving all parish corporations to this payroll processor also provided the opportunity to consolidate our payrolls. To run a separate payroll for each organization would have had an added cost. We consolidated our payrolls under Pope John XXIII School and St. Boniface Parish so that instead of paying more to a payroll service provider, we could return those resources to our employees.

In February 2019, Archbishop Lucas announced changes in our diocese's safe environment policy. These changes are the effect of the US Bishops' (USCCB) 2018 revisions to the *Charter for the Protection of Young Peoples*. This expands the list of those that need to be certified to include:

- All volunteers at parish festivals and bazaars
- Knights of Columbus who volunteer at activities hosted on parish grounds
 - Note: Knights of Columbus also have their own policies over certification
 - Both sets of policies must be followed
- All parish employees, regardless of whether their job entails contact with youth
- Eucharistic Ministers of Holy Communion and all involved in any homebound ministry

These changes will be implemented over the next 2 years.

In May 2019, the Archdiocese Vicar for Clergy's Office established a Clergy *Code of Conduct* applying to priests and deacons. This defines 'appropriate boundaries' of how clergy are meant to relate to the people of God. In addition, our Vicar for Clergy has pressured us to come up with alternatives to having offices in priest residences. The Vicar for Clergy wants separation between home and work for priests. He also wants us priests to live in the same rectory. Right now, we are not making any changes to our office structures. By July 2020, however, we will have to make some changes to our priest living and working environments.

Know of my prayers for all those beginning their school years. It comes with some initial craziness, but there is something to be said for "blessed routine" again!
