PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE OACCW BYLAWS 2024

ARTICLE I, Name – add acronym of OACCW

ARTICLE VI, OACCW Board Members, Section 2 et al – edit changes to have same type parenthetical enclosures throughout document

ARTICLE VI, OACCW Board Members, Section 2 d) 2-

ARTICLE VII, Officers, Section 1

ARTICLE VIII, Executive Board

ARTICLE XIII, Elections, Section 2

-the above 4 proposed amendments all concern elimination of the 2nd Vice President position with applicable changes

ARTICLE VI, OACCW Board Members, Section 2 – adding Section 2.g) for new task performer positions

ARTICLE VI, OACCW Board Members, Section 3 a) and b), Term of Office – changing terms of office to coincide with reality of terms being serve, eliminating term limits and lapses in serving terms

ARTICLE VI, OACCW Board Members, Section 4- clarification on Ordinary of the Archdiocese to be the Archbishop

ARTICLE VI, OACCW Board Members, Section 5 – removal of unexcused absences but addition of regular attendance is expected and encouraged

ARTICLE VII, Officers, Section 2 – how a vacancy in a position will be handled

ARTICLE IX, Meetings – inserting Section 4 to deal with digital meetings

ARTICLE X, Dues, Section 1- clarification on which dues are payable to NCCW

ARTICLE XI, Committees, Section 2- inserting other diocesan-experienced (outside of our diocese) members as women eligible to serve in OACCW

ARTICLE XIII, Elections, Section 1- clarification of other 3 deaneries who would elect board members in odd-numbered years

ARTICLE XIV, Duties of Officers, Section 4- inserting that Vice President responsible for updating the Board Member list each November for distribution at said meeting

ARTICLE XIV, Duties of Officers, Section 6- clarifying what Treasurer can pay by inserting financial obligations approved in the Standing Rules can be paid automatically (without voting each time)

ARTICLE XIV, Duties of Officers, Section 7-9 – these sections added with new Task Performers to act in lieu of 2nd Vice President, namely Lifetime Membership Chair, Publicity Chair and Toastmistress, without set terms, but garnering credit toward Lifetime Membership, with exception of the Pre-Convention Toastmistress due to its infrequency.

ARTICLE XV, Audit- striking “qualified auditor” and inserting “two non-involved parties” who would audit books and sign off report with report to be presented at first meeting of the year, usually in February.

PUNCTUATION, CAPITALIZATION AND GRAMMAR – changes throughout document where appropriate to add/change punctuation, capitalize/not capitalize, grammar changes.

ALPHA/NUMERIC RESEQUENCING – assigning new numerical or alphabetical values when items removed or inserted to flow in correct sequence.

GLOSSARY- inserted acronym for CCW and common acronyms for our deaneries along with the word “Diocesan” in the DCCW explanation of acronyms for Lincoln and Grand Island.
