### **Know YOUR Faith**

**JOIN FR. SUND WEEKLY FOR A LESSON IN FAITH** 



The Church teaches that the Most Holy Eucharist is the "Source and Summit" of all the activity, prayer and life of the Church. It is from the Eucharist that we gain our strength and our nourished and it is also to the Eucharist that all our efforts strive. On this line of thought it should be remembered that all prayer should lead me closer to Jesus in the Eucharist.

In Catholic thought my prayer should always take me closer to Jesus in the most Holy Eucharist. The moment of receiving the Most Holy Eucharist is the highest point we can obtain in the life of prayer, as it is the union and oneness with Christ. Just because we don't subjectively feel this all the time does not mean it is not a fact. Even if I have never felt anything when receiving Jesus, he in reality is as close to me as he has been to anyone in history at this moment!

The goal of our life of prayer is to help us realize this - so that when we receive Jesus' body and blood we are able to have as few obstacles as possible from experience his grace and presence in our own lives!
