From the Desk of Father Frank



Dear parishioners,

As I mentioned in last week's letter, the first OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation for Adults) will take place at 1:30 p.m. next Sunday in the church basement at St. Francis in Neligh. It will be an introductory meeting for the two formats I will be doing. The first will be weekly classes on most Sundays at 1:30 pm until next Easter. This is for those who have a limited background in Christianity or who seek a more comprehensive understanding of the Bible and the Catholic Church. Each class will end by 3 pm.

The other format will be a condensed version for those who have a stronger Christian or Catholic background. At next week's introductory session, we will determine the best time for the second class. Each class will be set up according to the group's availability. It will not be held on Sundays, and therefore, it will take factors such as harvesting into consideration for scheduling. The classes will be approximately two hours long, and there will be only about six sessions after the introduction. These sessions should be very helpful for those who may have someone pressuring them to become Catholic and are willing to give learning more a try.

One of the things I want to emphasize in these classes is the importance of family to God. In this era in which the family is being attacked, it is essential to recognize that God has not changed His mind and now desires to work through a different model. As the roles of father and mother are being mocked or disregarded, God and the Catholic Church glorify them as they celebrate God as our father and Mary as our spiritual mother, the King of heaven and Mary as the queen mother.

As I hope you have noticed about me, I am very proud of the Catholic faith. The richness that comes from our communion of Saints, our church art and architecture, our extensive teachings on justice and morality, and the beauty of how our Sacraments help us throughout our lives are amazing. We also have our yearly celebrations of pivotal feasts, memorials, and solemnities; and even the many sacramentals, such as palms, ashes, medals, and the most common element, holy water, reinforce us from day to day and even minute to minute. Then we have the incredible minds of St. Augustine, St. Thomas Aquinas, St. Pope John Paul II, the many Church Fathers, and the men and women who have been named Doctors of the Church. Then we have generation after generation of movers and shakers, such as St. Francis of Assisi, St. Anthony of Padua, and St. Teresa of Calcutta, who challenge us to show more love to our neighbors. I continue to learn more each year, and I have had a full 26 years of Catholic education. The good news is that my mind automatically brings most of what I have learned down to a fifth-grade level. So, I hope this works out for many of you. If not, I imagine I'll be doing it again next year.
