SPIRITUAL OIL CHANGE... A CHECKUP OF SORTS

We don't believe that God lives disinterested and distant from us. We believe that God is present in our lives and is active in our lives...wherever that takes us and wherever that takes him. Because God is interested in our hearts, he never stops seeking to initiate a deeper relationship with us. In the book of Revelation 3:20, Jesus says, "Behold I stand at the door and knock."

It's not unlike a spiritual oil change. My life as a priest includes a lot of miles in the car. Every so many miles, I need to stop and see the mechanic and get an oil change. When this happens, my car gets a 'look over' to see if something is out of alignment. At times in my life, my relationship with Jesus needs a 'look over', because he could be knocking at the door of my heart and be unheard or unheeded.

As Jesus makes the invitation, I want to be able to respond. Even more, Jesus gives me the grace at a given moment to say 'yes' where I might normally hesitate. This Fall gives us an invitation to see where we are in our relationship with the Lord.

BECOMING CATHOLIC...OR AT LEAST INVESTIGATING IT...

The Greek word 'catholicos' means universal... and that means that the Catholic Church is meant to have a welcome mat. If you are not Catholic and are interested in learning about the Catholic faith and our beliefs and practices, we host 'classes' and discussion in a process called RCIA, the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. It is a way to learn about our faith and decide if you would like to join. We take the time to learn and discuss. I'd be happy to discuss this opportunity with anyone interested. CATCHING UP ON SACRAMENTS...IT'S POSSIBLE

Sacraments are privileged moments of grace given to us. Sometimes life circumstances and changes mean that we missed out on receiving a sacrament when others did. Sometimes there are circumstances that delay the Baptism of a child, sometimes we've never received or used the Sacrament of Reconciliation, sometimes we've never received Holy Communion for the first time, or maybe we were never Confirmed. It is possible to be prepared for these sacraments and receive them. Please know that the opportunity is there. This year I'm leading adult sacrament preparation through RCIA and/or private instruction as the case may require... likely on Sunday afternoons. I'd be happy to discuss your situation. MARRIAGE IN THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

Since marriage is considered a sacrament in the Catholic Church, it is important to have your marriage relationship recognized under the laws of the Catholic Church. Sometimes our life situations are complex and complicated. We want to offer a desire to help and a willingness to walk with you through steps to bring resolution or healing as best we can. Sometimes regularizing a situation is very straightforward and sometimes it can take time with an annulment process. But since this is important, we want to offer to accompany you in this way. Please don't hesitate to reach out and talk through your situation. Sometimes you can have a feeling that "I want to get this worked out"... remember that asking and getting the information is a first step that lets you decide how to proceed.

GROWING IN FAITH... MATURING IN FAITH...

One of the scriptural images that I find so helpful is the disciples on the road to Emmaus (Lk 24:13-35). They are making a journey, and Jesus draws near to them. They don't recognize him, but he is there. Jesus starts a conversation that prompts their hearts. The tug in their hearts made it the right moment to respond to Jesus. When they finally recognize Jesus, they realize he was there with them along the way.

In our own lives, we can sometimes stall our walk of faith by saying, "Why now?" The truth is that the moment when the Lord knocks or when Jesus tugs at our heart is the right moment to respond. There's a bit of mystery about why my story is told one way and another's story unfolds a different way. We are meant to rejoice in the fact that Jesus is writing our own unique story of salvation. We are made for union with him.

We want to respond to that knock at the door of our heart.






The Man of the Shroud

- 1. The rosary is known as the "bible on a string" because the Mysteries of the Rosary share the Gospel.
- 2. Catholics are often buried with a rosary for protection.
- 2. The world's largest rosary is 1965 feet long and is in Beirut. It includes 59 large concrete beads and each one is the size of a car!
- 4. Catholics have been praying the rosary as we know it today since the 13th Century, but monks and hermits as early as the 3rd century used rocks and prayer beads in a similar way.
- 5. St. Thomas Aquinas gave the longest (known) homily on the rosary and it lasted FORTY days.

Steps for Vocational Discernment

- 1. *Remember to make time for silence*-Our lives today are full of noise and busyness, which can make vocational discernment challenging.
- 2. *It's not to be a scramble*.-Discerning your vocation and your place in the Catholic church isn't meant to be a rushed, anxious process.
- 3. *Your vocation isn't a puzzle*.-God doesn't hide things from us to tease us. In prayer, the Holy Spirit can inspire a sense of vocation in your interior life.
- 4. *It's not about the right amount of planning*.-God isn't waiting for you to complete your check list to reveal to you whether he's calling you to marriage, religious life, or a life of ministry.
- 5. Sacrifice isn't something to be afraid of.-Discerning God's mission for your life will require sacrifice. But that's not something to be afraid of.
- 6. *Trust God with your vocation.*-God desires your good. He's a father who has his children's best interest at heart.
- 7. Ask God what he wants for your life.-Prayer is a conversation with God. But it's also meant to be an opportunity where we conform our will to the will of the Father.
- 8. *Our Lady will walk this path with you.*-Not only do you have the support of the saints, but you also have the Blessed Mother as a source of encouragement.
- 9. **Be on the look out for joy**.-During your vocational discernment, it's important to seek joy. "You will know your vocation by the joy that it brings you,"-*Dorothy Day*.
- 10. *Listen to the inspirations of the Holy Spirit*.-The desire that God places on your heart is there for a reason. He doesn't inspire us without meaning.
- 11. *Pray for God's will in your vocation.*-Don't be afraid to surrender your vocation to God.

Consider if your teenage son had the ambition and the ability to become an architect. Most parents would encourage this interest, even going out of their way to research the best colleges for architecture. But the same parents, express reservation about their son attending seminary. Why would you encourage your son to learn how to build roads and bridges, but discourage him because he wants to build the Kingdom of God?
