

#### MATTER OF PERSPECTIVE... RIGHT-SIDE UP AND UPSIDE DOWN

If you only saw one of the faces pictured above, and if someone else only saw the other face pictured, you may not immediately see or know that both faces are the same... one is just upside down compared to the other... flip the bulletin around if you want to check!

If we didn't have the images side-by-side, our perspective, considerations and understanding might be limited. As we approach Election Day in November, the Catholic Church has a role to play in forming our consciences. This isn't meant as an endorsement of a political party or of any candidate. Compared to the perfection of our savior Jesus Christ, every political party and every candidate falls short. Fr. Vogel and I will be writing columns these next weeks about Catholic Social Teaching.

The issues and principles raised are meant to help us see issues more clearly with their implications and perhaps even to understand another perspective of an issue. We are not telling you who to vote for, but we are trying to empower your ability to choose and vote from a formed conscience.

The four principles that we will discuss in greater detail are:

- The Dignity of the Human Person
- The Principle of the Common Good
- The Principle of Solidarity
- The Principle of Subsidiarity

#### SO WHY SHOULD THE CHURCH SPEAK AT ALL?

Let's look at the impact of faith. Faith colors our entire understanding of the world in which we live. We see the world differently and prioritize things differently because we are believers. Since we prioritize and view things differently... and live differently because of faith... it has an impact on what we choose to do in our role in society.

At the same time, our society has passed legislation and put forward legal understandings that challenge the Church or even coerce the Church in its role and mission. Our society does not have a relativistic laisse faire 'live and let live' point of view. That point of view has its own limitations and problems. Instead, our society has opted to become more polarized and militant about elevating a single viewpoint as correct and making accusations toward those who disagree. This limits the ability to have a conversation and deliberate on a complex issue and proposed solutions. Candidates with positions on issues are not unlike cable packages, where you often get some channels you really like and some that you don't.

#### FOUR PRINCIPLES BRIEFLY DEFINED

The dignity of the human person recognizes each person as made in the image and likeness of God. Each person has a dignity and value that cannot be compromised.

The principle of the common good recognizes that we seek to live as a human family. Our policies should seek to protect human rights and fulfill basic responsibilities as a society.

The principle of solidarity recognizes that 'we are all in this together.' We are one human family, and we seek to support those treated unfairly, the forgotten, and those in need.

The principle of subsidiarity recognizes that supporting the foundational elements of a society strengthens the society, and weakening the foundational elements weakens our society. Our society's foundational element is the family. It is from the families and households of our communities that we have local towns and communities, communities of faith, and our larger governance structures of county, state, and federal government.

#### CHANGES TO OUR CHURCH WORSHIP IN OCTOBER

Beginning the weekend of October 3-4, there will be several logistical changes in using our worship spaces in Phase IV:

- 1) The 'half' of the church building on the ambo side of the church (where the readings happen) will be allowed to use every pew. Distancing is encouraged where possible.
- 2) The other 'half' of the church building will continue to be seated every other pew with required distancing.
- 3) For communion, both sides of the church will come forward using the side aisles to come forward and returning using the main aisle. Note: St. Theresa's flow will be modified to the space.
- 4) With the exception of St. Boniface in Elgin, all of the churches will return pew missalettes to their normal spots. St. Boniface's books will be handled differently with Sunday books and school mass books.

Please be respectful of our safety practices. It is important to remember that we have a type of co-responsibility in this. We have to look out for each other, especially the most vulnerable.
