Dear parishioners,

Now that we are officially done with summer and are watching everything change for fall, it might be time to check your prayer schedule. Hopefully, you have one. Mine is fairly simple. I usually attend Mass or two in the morning, then I have anywhere between 25 and 40 pages of prayers to recite for my Divine Office. There are special readings for each day, morning prayers, mid-day prayers, evening prayers, and night prayers. That would work great if I were a monk, and the whole routine would include those. I'm not a monk, even though I have always thought I should start a monastery for night people. All the monasteries I know of are geared for morning people. However, this helps make my point clear. I'm not a monk, but I am a night person. When should I pray, and does that change during different parts of my life? The answer is yes.

Because I am a night person, I do my homily preparation at night, then I usually need to make a note or two so I can remember what I came up with the night before. I didn't have to do that years ago. That is one change. Because I am a night person, most of my prayers are said toward the end of the day. I'm not at my best in the morning, so praying in the morning would be a grumpy time. I want to give God my best.

Depending on the season or the responsibilities of my parish assignment, I also need to adjust my prayer time and meditation. Meditation is for when I have a little time in between activities. I need that meditation time, so when I have been in a crazy busy assignment, I must block out some time for that. With harvesting time approaching, many of you need to consider how to fit these tasks into your busy schedule. Don't ignore God when you need to appreciate His work the most.

With shorter days and less sunlight, it is also time to evaluate what scripture you want to read to help with your meditation time. Some of you have been working with mediation booklets. They follow the church calendar and therefore have built-in alterations. I've always wondered about the people in the southern hemisphere and how their seasons don't align with the church calendar, such as having Christmas right when winter begins, or Easter celebrations in the midst of their fall season. We need to make prayer adjustments for any changes in life that occur, such as marriage, new babies, health issues, job changes, and seasonal changes. If we are conscious of this, we may slowly sink into spiritual sloth.

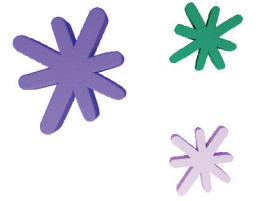

7-12th Youth Formation

- The Youth Group at Tintern for 9th-12th grade will start at 5:30 on Sunday, September 28.
