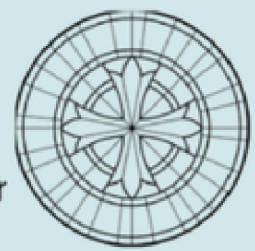

Selling Grain to Benefit Your Church:

Producers are encouraged to donate grain to your parish this fall, and all year! Please deliver your commodity to the facility and tell them that the grain now belongs to the parish (or school) entity. The donor signs a form either at the facility or at the parish office, stating that the grain belongs to the entity and check the box of what you want it donated for (God's Portion, Sunday Collection Etc.) The facility mails the check/scale ticket to the charity.

NOTE: Check with your own tax accountant for questions about tax liability.
