## HAVING CONVERSATIONS IS HARD WORK

It's become a lot harder to have conversations in our modern world. Listening both involves both hearing and understanding. It can be hard work to understand another person's perspective. Oftentimes, we can start thinking about a response before we've fully heard what is said. When conversations do not end in agreement, our culture can tempt us to write off, misrepresent or misconstrue the other person's viewpoint.

Complex issues and situations rarely have simple solutions that address every facet of the complexity. Real world problems are often complex, and our efforts to address these problems often do not address every scenario. Problem solving is about moving the football down the field. Not every solution is a touchdown, but every effort is about making forward progress.

## CONTEXT FOR A CONVERSATION

Within our Family of Parishes, it's a good time for an update. The Archdiocese of Omaha has been directing us through a pastoral planning process called Journey of Faith (JoF). The process has called on us to look at our resources – our priests, our parishioners, and our campuses – and plan for a future in which we have 8 parishes and 2 priests. The JoF process has a ten-year planning horizon thru 2033. The Archbishop is calling on each parish to become a 'missional community' for evangelizing and spreading the Good News of Jesus Christ.

Archbishop Lucas feels strongly that the time to plan and take action is now. Saturday was the Pastoral Conference '22 for the Archdiocese of Omaha. Replay of their content is available at <https://archomaha.org/pc22/>. Some of the factors that are pressuring us into a time of action may sound familiar... 1)Declining Mass Attendance, 2)Shifting Demographics, and 3)Declining Priest Availability.

**One of the 'myths' that we need to address and dispel is that "If we had more priests, we wouldn't have to change anything."**

The Church is over 2000 years old and has undergone change and

renewal since the beginning. Our contemporary context still has to contend with shifting demographics (for us, this means area depopulation) and declining Mass attendance. We have to evaluate the life and future of our churches.

The same trends, pressures, and challenges that affect our rural communities outside of a church context/conversation are still relevant factors inside our church planning and conversations.

The easiest of these issues to address is "Declining Priest Availability" since the Archdiocese has determined that our pastoral area will include 8 churches and 2 priests. This assignment covers a geographic territory of almost 1400 sq. miles (which is about 10% of the land area of the Archdiocese). We have been given our priest resources, and now we have to plan and work with what we have.

## CONVERSATIONS AND PLANNING IN OUR PARISHES

Two of the planning priorities from the Archdiocese speak to flourishing parishes and flourishing priests. Having our large territory to cover, we have to have conversations about what the expectations of priest workloads look like. While I am very much motivated by serving, working our priests to death is not a good strategy for a vibrant future. Additionally, we want the experience of parish life to be enriching and supportive. We live in a world increasingly hostile to the Gospel, and we need to encourage each other. We have a proud history and heritage of faith. We are stewards of large physical campuses. Some of the buildings we have actively serve a 'mission' purpose while other buildings are underutilized or mothballed. The planning process involves discussing what we have and what we need... and how we plan to continue to maintain buildings in the service of our mission. Maintaining buildings costs money... and the Archdiocese is challenging us to consider not just "can we" but "should we" continue to maintain all of our buildings. Some might have a better purpose of use in our communities.

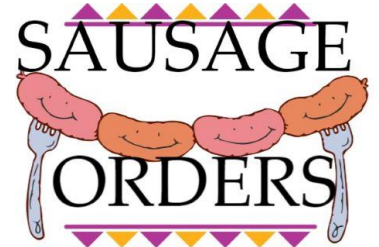
