

Dear parishioners,

I have one more idea I would like to share concerning this change of seasons. For those of you who are not harvesting, these next weeks can bring about a tough thing to shake, dread. It is the dread of winter, of the loss of long and sunny days, the coming of snow, ice, and cold. For most of us, that is not our prime time. This feeling of dread can creep up on us and bring us down if we recognize it for what it is. It is not an actual problem. It is like worry, which also doesn't solve anything. I used to have a poster that helped me with this. It said, "Worrying doesn't solve anything, but it gives me something to do until the trouble starts." Why waste days that can be productive and filled with God's adventures for us with dread or worry? Or as Jesus says, "Do not worry about tomorrow; tomorrow will take care of itself. Sufficient for a day is its own evil.

We are to face the things God asks of us today without adding the added weight of what we imagine might happen tomorrow. Those of you who have already completed the harvest should have an easier time of this for the moment, as you are busy with productive work and hopefully giving thanks to God for what He has done for us this year, for more people, which makes things easier. In fact, it is the key to overcoming dread. Be productive. Make a list of things you can accomplish. Check them off one by one. Enjoy the little gifts that come from God each day, such as the sunrise or sunset, and thank Him. All of this is the opposite of dread and a lot more fun.

All Saints' Day is a joyful celebration of all the saints, known and unknown, who now live in the fullness of God's presence in Heaven. This feast reminds us that holiness isn't just for a few extraordinary people, but a call for each of us. The saints were ordinary men and women who lived with exceptional faith, love, and perseverance. They show us what it means to follow Christ in everyday life.

A Day for Reflection:

As we honor the saints, take time to think about the people who have shaped your faith—family members, friends, or community members who lived with quiet holiness. Reflect on these questions:

- What virtues or actions make someone a "saint" in your eyes?
- How can I live my daily life in a way that draws me closer to God?
- What can I learn from the example of my favorite saint?

How to Celebrate All Saints' Day:

- Attend Mass All Saints' Day is a Holy Day of Obligation, a time to worship and give thanks for the saints' intercession and example.
- Pray with the Saints Ask for their prayers and guidance in your life.
- Learn About a Saint Read the story of a saint who inspires you or your family.
- Honor Loved Ones Light a candle or say a prayer for loved ones who have gone before you in faith.
- Live Like a Saint Do an act of kindness, forgiveness, or mercy in their honor.

All Saints' Day reminds us that we are all called to holiness. The same grace that made the saints holy is available to us today. Let us rejoice in our heavenly family and strive to follow their example of love and faithfulness.
