This weekend we welcome Archbishop George J. Lucas on his parish pastoral visit to St John the Baptist in Petersburg, St. Boniface in Elgin, and St. Bonaventure in Raeville. He will celebrate the three weekend Masses and will also celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation. We also welcome Fr. Dave Liewer, former pastor of St. Peter's in Ewing, to St. Peter's, St. Theresa's in Clearwater, and Rural St. John's parishes.

#### CREATING A CULTURE OF UNITY

A few years ago, the Archdiocese went through a visioning process to seek to focus our efforts and energy. This is when the Archdiocese adopted the pastoral vision of One Church: Encountering Jesus, Equipping Disciples, Living Mercy. At the same time, some goals were established to help us live this pastoral vision. One of the Archdiocese goals is "Create a Culture of Unity". I think that it's important for us to reflect on what that means.

#### **COMMUNICATION IS KEY**

A common challenge to unity is communication. Sometimes a different spoken or written language can get in the way, like in the Tower of Babel (Gen 11:1-9), where different languages stopped the ability to complete the project that they were working on. If I wrote my column in Italian or Biblical Greek, it would be harder to understand.

At the same time, sometimes using the same English language still causes us to be misunderstood. The words that we use are meant to convey the concepts and meanings behind the words. Some information can be shared in a written way like a letter or email or text

message. Some information can be shared in a verbal way like a phone call. Some information is best shared in person where you can see the person, hear what the person is saying, and hear how the person is saying it.

#### CONTEXT FOR THE MESSAGE

You might be curious why I take the time to break this down. You might also wonder if the listed differences matter as much as I seem to think. Part of this is that I was trained in philosophy, which seeks to better understand the world through reflection and questioning. Part of this is the experience of being in several different parishes over my six years of priesthood.

Experience has taught me this: each parish community of faith means something different by the phrase "Father, we take care of that." Whether it's getting things ready for Mass, washing altar linens, decorating the church, taking care of the parish grounds and cemeteries, providing religious education, fundraising, having parish or community events, doing maintenance projects, etc., the end result is different in every church where I've been assigned. And these are the physical cares and concerns, preparing the way for our spiritual cares and concerns.

COMMUNICATION TAKES TIME AND UNDERSTANDING

In our busy world, we want to get so many things done NOW! We want to be quick and efficient. Being pulled in many different directions can mean that we don't want to spend a second more than is necessary to accomplish something. Saying something... putting it out there... is not the same as communicating. The care we need in communication is not "Did you get my message?" but rather "Did you understand my message?" If not, then we have to try again. If I say, "Seek Jesus!", do you know what I mean by that? If we say our goal is "To make disciples", do we know what we want to accomplish? If we say "Together", do we know what that truly means?

Those statements could mean many different things. That's part of the reason why we must take the time and seek to understand and to be understood as our communities of faith come together.


