LOOKING TO BEGIN ANOTHER YEAR OF GRACE

Every year around Thanksgiving time we celebrate the Feast of Christ the King, end one church year, and begin a new church year with the season of Advent. There has been a lot of turmoil in 2020: we encountered a pandemic for the first time in many of our lifetimes, we've been forced to think about how we live life and interact with people differently, we probably know at least one person who has gotten sick, and we probably have heard the word 'Zoom' more than we would like. It's been a hard year on people... on us... and it continues to be that way.

BEING CHURCH... AND A COMMUNITY OF BELIEVERS IN THIS The Church has also been impacted by this context. I never thought that I would tell people that they couldn't come to church. I never expected the disorientation I would feel with the physical separation from our communities of faith. I never knew how weird it would be to celebrate Easter Mass in front of a camera in an empty building. Right now, I'm very grateful for our ability to gather... even while noting that it is not normal.

CHRISTMAS ACCOMMODATIONS FOR COVID

As we plan for Christmas in the midst of COVID-world, we are making some accommodations... for this year only. Since we may have many travelers from outside our communities coming, prudence will require us to be seated every other pew and we again strongly encourage with our local health departments the wearing of a face covering. While not ideal, we are expanding our ability to handle overflow in parish halls and such. We are also adding mass times, hoping that we can safely accommodate as many as possible inside our church buildings.

OUR PARISH GROUPING BECOMES A FAMILY

Language sometimes helps express a reality. When the Archdiocese began drawing large circles on a map and using the term 'parish groupings', the Archdiocese was articulating a type of management structure for the priests that would be assigned. Since then, areas of the larger Church (most notably in the Diocese of London, Ontario, Canada and the Archdiocese of Detroit) has adopted relational language to talk about the goal here. Instead of using the term parish grouping, we will begin using the term family of parishes. While the language of 'family' can be complicated and messy at times, it also expresses the truth that we have a future of educating, forming, and passing on the faith in a larger and extended family context. We are all meant to help each other, rather than to feel separated and siloed in our individual parishes. What's happening in a neighboring parish is no longer 'the competition' but is celebration of our larger family.

PRIEST CHANGES WITHIN OUR FAMILY OF PARISHES

Firstly, this is not an announcement of Fr. Vogel or I taking a different assignment in the diocese. Since the 2018 beginning of the investigation by the State of Nebraska's Attorney General, the Archdiocese of Omaha has been making policy changes concerning priest personnel. There is now a "Clergy Code of Conduct" and a ministerial review board to advise the archbishop on situations where a priest is not living in accord with this code. When we were reorganizing into this family of parishes, we were encouraged to find a residence where we could live together. Now, in implementing the code of conduct, we are being asked to separate living space from working space. Basically, the instructions boiled down to "get the office out of the house... or get the house out of the office." Fr. Vogel and I have evaluated the five current rectories in the six parishes, and in order to enact this, both of us will be moving into the rectory at Petersburg.

The current plan is for Fr. Vogel to move in January 2021, and I will move in July 2021. The rectory in Ewing will continue to serve as an office. There will continue to be an office in Werner Hall in Petersburg. The rectory in Elgin will be completely transitioned into being office space. As a priest team, this will allow us to have more time to interact. We will be capable of providing emergency coverage as a backup to Antelope Memorial Hospital in Neligh and to Boone County Health in Albion. As we transition into this, we will be very intentional about being present. Neither of us have been unhappy with the communities we called home, but this is a change that we needed to make.
