From the Desk of Father Frank



Dear parishioners,

I hope you had some rest during the Thanksgiving holiday. Now we start Advent, and then the Christmas season. This is a good time to think about the people around us. St. Paul deals with one aspect of this in his 1st Letter to the Corinthians 11:20-22a. "When you meet in one place, then, it is not to eat the Lord's supper, for in eating, each one goes ahead with his own supper, and one goes hungry while another gets drunk. Do you not have houses in which you can eat and drink? Or do you show contempt for the church of God and make those who have nothing feel ashamed?" The Mass was not as structured back then as it is now. They were gathering in homes, not in churches. Some were bringing extra food for themselves, while ignoring that others had nothing. He was telling them that they should stop having their own supper and focus on the Lord's supper.

This is some of what many think about during these holidays. We do what we can to help those who lack necessities. That is great. What I want to mention is a different aspect of this that has changed over the years. Growing up, I remember getting all dressed up for church. Our shoes were polished the night before. We wore a sports coat and a tie. Ours were clip-on bow ties. We even had our weekly bath the night before. That all sounds strange now. Most of us don't dress up as much now. What happened?

Back then, we were focusing on being presentable to the Lord. President Trump expects this of leaders coming to the White House. Why the change? First of all, we changed our attitude toward the Lord. We started to think of the Mass as a communal meal with all of us sitting in a circle at the Lord's table. Some churches took on this design. It helped us to feel more connected with God. Some of us also realized, as St. Paul did, that some people felt ashamed because they did not have nice clothes. Jesus had a special love for the poor, so should we.

Which is right? Do we dress up in fancy clothes, or do we stay low-key and help make people feel welcome? As usual, the church's answer is both. Like Jesus, we should be welcoming, but we should also be mindful of the message we are giving to God and to those around us.

One example of this was in a fairly affluent parish I served: three mechanics would come into the Sunday evening Mass at the last minute, wearing coveralls. They received some very unwelcoming looks. I took the time to get to know them. They worked at a service station in the neighborhood, and this was their only chance to get to Mass, but it was a rush to make it on time. I was proud of them, and once I let people know their circumstances, so were they. That is why we need to get to know the people around us and what effect our dress and behavior have on them. I'll deal with the drunk part of that quote from St. Paul in another letter.

The Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary
December 8, 2025

Why we celebrate...

Each year on December 8th, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, one of the most important Marian feasts. This feast honors the moment Mary herself was conceived in the womb of her mother, St. Anne.

The doctrine of the Immaculate Conception teaches that, from the very first moment of her existence, Mary was preserved by God from original sin. This special grace was given in view of the mission she would undertake as the Mother of God. Because Jesus is entirely God and fully human, He should have been born of a woman untouched by sin, a pure vessel prepared for His coming. Celebrating this feast reminds us of God's immense love and His plan for our salvation. Mary's "yes" was only possible because of God's grace working in her life from the start. As we honor her Immaculate Conception, we are invited to reflect on the power of God's grace in our own lives and to imitate Mary's openness to God's will.

How we celebrate...

- **Attend Mass** – As a Holy Day of Obligation, participating in the Eucharist is the most important way to celebrate and give thanks for God's gift of Mary.
- **Pray the Rosary** – Meditating on the mysteries of Christ through Mary draws us closer to both her and her Son. The Joyful Mysteries are especially fitting for this feast.
- **Offer a Marian Prayer** – A simple prayer, such as the Hail Mary, the Memorare, or the Hail Holy Queen, is a beautiful way to honor her.
